Dear Governor Walz, Senators, Representatives, Executive Director Weber, and Revisor Inman:



The Board has completed its annual review of its rules and did not identify any obsolete, unnecessary or duplicative rules.

The Board is working on an expedited rule package governing qualifications for initial certification and interstate mobility, Revisor's ID number R-04940, and plans to complete adoption within the next two months.
