“(a) By January 15 each year, each agency must submit its rulemaking docket maintained under section 14.366 and the official rulemaking record required under section 14.365 for any rule adopted during the preceding calendar year, to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative policy and budget committees with jurisdiction over the subject matter of the proposed rule.”

## Adopted Rules

The Department of Revenue (Revenue) adopted one rule amendment in 2025.

### Tax Administration – Repeated Failures to Pay Taxes [R-4838](#)

Amended Minnesota Rules, part 8175.0100, subpart 1 to replace citations to repealed statutes with current citations. Revenue moved to amend this rule under the good cause exemption procedures outlined in Minnesota Statutes, section 14.388.

The Commissioner of Revenue signed the order adopting the rule amendment on March 26, 2025, and the final rule amendment was published in the State Register on April 14, 2025.

## Rulemaking in Progress and Rulemaking Records

Revenue currently has no active rulemaking projects.
