Residential Electric Panel Upgrade Grant Program

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 216C.45, subd. 10 the Minnesota Department of Commerce presents this 2025 Annual Report regarding Minnesota Residential Electric Panel Upgrade Grant Program projects implemented under the program.

As of the date this report is published, the Residential Electric Panel Upgrade Grant program is under development. There were no grant recipients during 2025 and therefore, zero units in multifamily buildings and zero single-family residents whose owners' received grants.

The program is on track to launch in 2026 and will be integrated with Minnesota's Home Energy Rebate Programs (branded as Save Energy Minnesota) funded by the U.S. Department of Energy. The long timeline for launching that federally funded program has delayed the launch of this companion state program.
