**Re: Section 14.116 (a) Notice to Legislature**

Dear Legislators:

The Campaign Finance and Public Disclosure Board recently adopted [exempt administrative rules](#) amending portions of [Minnesota Rules 4503.0900](#) to conform to a newly-enacted statute, [Minnesota Statutes section 10A.174](#), as required by [Laws of Minnesota 2025, chapter 39, article 7, section 22](#). The exempt rules were published in the *State Register*, and became effective, on January 5, 2026.

Pursuant to [Minnesota Statutes section 14.116 \(a\)](#), the Board must annually submit its active rulemaking docket to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over the subject matter of the rules, as well as a copy of the official rulemaking record for any rule adopted during the preceding calendar year. Attached are copies of 1) the Board's [active rulemaking docket](#); and 2) the record for the above-referenced exempt rules.
