Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes section 14.116(a), this letter serves as the Office of Cannabis Management's (OCM) submission of its rulemaking docket maintained under Minnesota Statutes section 14.366, and the official rulemaking record required under Minnesota Statutes section 14.365 for any rule adopted during the preceding calendar year.
