


Statement of Revenue and Expenses for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2020; Unaudited

**The Foundation has accumulated net assets due to the recognition of multi-year pledges. These net assets are used in the years that pledge payments are received and expended for grants, program expenses, and operations. The exception are Zoo Capital Projects, funds for which are raised and kept at the Foundation until sufficient funds have been raised for the project to begin, at which time funds are granted to the Zoo.
