



Unemployment Insurance Reimbursement Aid

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Legislative Charge

As required by Minnesota Statutes 2023, Chapter 55, Article 1, Section 33, the Minnesota Department of Education (MDE), in consultation with the Department of Employment and Economic Development (DEED), must annually report to the legislative committees with jurisdiction over education the balances in unemployment insurance aid accounts and information about the annual changes in reimbursable costs for school workers receiving unemployment insurance benefits by January 15. To the extent possible, the report must break out the costs by district and major job classes. The report must be filed according to Minnesota Statutes 2025, section 3.195.

Background

Minnesota Statutes 2023, section 124D.995, established the School Unemployment Aid special revenue account, which included a one-time appropriation of \$135 million. The funds are to reimburse local educational agencies (LEAs) for the cost associated with providing unemployment benefits to eligible school employees under Minnesota Statutes 2023, section 268.085, subd. 7(b).

The 2025 legislature appropriated an additional onetime appropriation of \$100 million in fiscal year (FY) 2026 for unemployment aid under Minnesota Statutes, section 124D.995. In addition, the unemployment insurance report requirement under Minnesota Laws 2023, chapter 55, article 1, section 33 was amended to require the Unemployment Insurance Report to break out special education paraprofessionals from all other paraprofessionals.

This report provides information on the current known costs of those benefits paid by LEAs as of December 2, 2025 for expenses in FY 2026. The current known costs were provided via a voluntary survey conducted by MDE to LEAs, and as such are estimates only. Final, validated data for FY 2026 will be available in January 2027. Not all school districts and charter schools supplied information regarding eligible unemployment costs via the voluntary survey, and a preliminary review of survey submissions indicate that some data may have been provided in error.

Report

This report provides information on the current known costs to LEAs for unemployment benefits eligible for unemployment reimbursement aid under Minnesota Statutes 2023, section 124D.995, for the period from July 1, 2025 through forecasted June 30, 2026, as reported voluntarily through a survey to school districts, charter schools, cooperative, and intermediate districts. The survey was deployed in October and extended into November of 2025, and asked LEAs to provide the anticipated amount to be billed by DEED for unemployment benefits under Minnesota Statutes 2023, section 268.085, subd. 7(b). In addition, MDE asked LEAs to provide the total cost of these benefits for the following employment categories: 1) special education paraprofessional, 2) all other paraprofessional, 3) food service, 4) transportation, 5) clerical, 6) maintenance, and 7) other.

As a result of the survey, MDE issued a metered school unemployment aid payment to responding school districts and charter schools on November 30 and December 15, 2025, equal to 90 percent of their reported costs. In total, there was \$65.7 million in anticipated unemployment payments report to MDE by LEAs in the survey upon which MDE paid 90 percent. In addition, MDE expects the estimated total of \$70 million to be paid when FY 2026 data and corresponding payments are finalized. Final payments and adjustments to LEAs will be determined after final FY 2026 data submissions are received by MDE in December 2026 and subsequently validated in January 2027.

The statewide, unvalidated results for the major job classifications are as follows:

Although MDE encouraged participation in the survey, not all LEAs submitted information; thus, this report will not include all eligible costs. All LEAs will receive a final payment in January 2027 equal to their actual costs in FY 2026 even if the LEA did not submit estimates during the survey process. Since MDE is unable to validate the accuracy of data submitted via the voluntary survey process, any questions related to the LEA data included in this report should be directed to the specific LEA.

Conclusion

In FY 2024, MDE issued \$40.4 million in payments. FY 2025 is still being finalized, but so far MDE has issued \$54.9 million in payments with an estimated \$5.8 left to be expended. This leaves \$34.0 million left of the original \$135 million that was appropriated after the first two years of payments have been finalized.

Based on the voluntary survey data provided by LEAs and anticipated additional costs for the time period of July 1, 2025 through forecasted June 30, 2026, the preliminary distributions for FY 2026 are estimated to use the entirety of what remains of the original \$135 million appropriation plus \$36 million from the additional \$100 million appropriation.

Of the various expenditure types in the survey, almost half of the costs of benefits were reported in the special education paraprofessional employment category.

MDE will collect final data related to the FY 2026 school unemployment aid from school districts, charters, cooperatives, and intermediate districts through annual financial submission process by December 15, 2026. This will be reflected in the final payment and in the January 2027 legislative report.
