Executive Summary

Building soil health is key to facilitating resiliency across Minnesota's working lands in the face of a changing climate. However, soil health practices typically require specialized, expensive equipment that many producers do not own. To meet this challenge, the Soil Health Financial Assistance Program (SHFAP) was established to provide grants to individual producers, groups of producers, and local government units to purchase soil health equipment. Initially established as a \$500,000 pilot appropriation during the 2022 legislative session, the SHFAP received additional funding in subsequent legislative sessions, and as a result has offered four rounds of funding since initiated in 2023. The funding available in FY26 included a General Fund appropriation of \$639,000, a Clean Water Fund appropriation of \$1.75 million, and \$2,467,857.50 from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) via a Climate Pollution Reduction Grant. The EPA funds represent more than \$8 million in investments awarded to the SHFAP over a 4-year period in addition to the maintained match of state general fund \$639,000/year and clean water fund \$1,750,000 baseline funding.

The awards made in FY26 are the focus of this report. The FY25 awards are the subject of the Soil Health Financial Assistance Program Fiscal Year 2025 Legislative Report (Jan. 15, 2025), the FY24 awards were the subject of the Soil Health Financial Assistance Program Fiscal Year 2024 Legislative Report (Jan. 8, 2024), while the FY23 (pilot) awards were the subject of the Soil Health Financial Assistance Pilot Program Fiscal Year 2023 Legislative Report (Dec. 27, 2023).

Program Operations

A request for proposals for the SHFAP was open from Aug. 1 to Aug. 29, 2025, and generated 284 applications for more than \$8.6 million in requested support. Applications were competitively reviewed by an external review committee that scored and ranked applications based on their soil health benefit, financial need, potential for conservation practice co-benefits, and other factors. Grant award decisions were announced in December 2025. The FY26 request for proposal (RFP) marked the fourth funding cycle under the SHFAP, following the first (pilot) round and FY24 and FY25 rounds. RFPs for the previous funding cycles were open in winter and summer 2023 and summer 2024.

Grant awards

Using the General Fund appropriations, 22 awards totaling \$595,880.98 were made across 20 counties. Of the \$639,000 available from the General Fund, up to 6.5% or \$41,535, can be reserved for program administration. Table 1 shows grant awards under the General Fund appropriation by county. The equipment purchased through these grant awards will be used to implement a wide range of soil health practices on a minimum of 25,644 acres annually.

Tables 2, 3, and 4 show the individual awards made under the General Fund, Clean Water Fund, and EPA Climate Pollution Reduction Grant appropriations. Combined, these funding pools allowed a total of \$4,809,683.68 in SHFAP grant awards to 164 recipients. The equipment purchased with these grant awards will affect an estimated 217,031 acres annually.
