This letter is respectfully submitted in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 356B.215, subdivision 10. Each year, the Teachers Retirement Association (TRA) and Minnesota State must submit a report detailing, for the prior calendar year, the elective transfers of retirement plan coverage for eligible individuals from the Individual Retirement Account Plan (IRAP) to TRA.
