I. Executive Summary

This report provides a list of direct appropriation transfers approved by Minnesota Management & Budget (MMB) in the first two quarters of State Fiscal Year 2026. The time period included is July 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025.

II. Legislation

The following legislative authorities were cited in the transfers reported below.

Laws 2025 1st Special Session, Chapter 3, Article 20, Section 22, subd 3:

Beginning July 1, 2025, and until March 31, 2026, administrative money may be transferred between the Department of Human Services and Department of Children, Youth, and Families as the commissioners deem necessary, with the advance approval of the commissioner of management and budget. The commissioners shall report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over children and families quarterly about transfers made under this section.

Laws 2025 1st Special Session, Chapter 3, Article 22, Sec 23, subd 2:

Positions, salary money, and nonsalary administrative money may be transferred within the Department of Children, Youth, and Families as the commissioner deems necessary, with the advance approval of the commissioner of management and budget. The commissioner shall report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over children and families finance quarterly about transfers made under this subdivision.

Laws 2025 1st Special Session, Chapter 3, Article 22, Sec 23, subd 3:

Beginning July 1, 2025, and until March 31, 2026, administrative money may be transferred between the Department of Children, Youth, and Families and the Department of Human Services or the Department of Education as the commissioners deem necessary, with the advance approval of the commissioner of management and budget. The commissioners shall report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over children and families finance and policy quarterly about transfers made under this subdivision.

Minnesota Statutes 16A.285:

An agency in the executive, legislative, or judicial branch may transfer state agency operational money between programs within the same fund if: (1) the agency first notifies the commissioner as to the type and intent of the transfer; and (2) the transfer is consistent with legislative intent. If an amount is specified for an item within an activity, that amount must not be transferred or used for any other purpose.

The commissioner shall report the transfers to the chairs of the senate finance and house of representatives ways and means committees.

Laws 2024, Chapter 115, Article 22, Section 10, Subd. 2:

Laws 2023, chapter 70, article 20, section 23, is amended to read:

Sec. 23. TRANSFERS.

Subdivision 1. Grants. The commissioner of human services and commissioner of children, youth, and families, with the approval of the commissioner of management and budget, may transfer unencumbered appropriation balances for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, within fiscal years among MFIP; general assistance; medical assistance; MinnesotaCare; MFIP child care assistance under Minnesota Statutes, section 119B.05; Minnesota supplemental aid program; housing support program; the entitlement portion of Northstar Care for Children under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 256N; and the entitlement portion of the behavioral health fund between fiscal years of the biennium. The commissioner shall report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over health and human services quarterly about transfers made under this subdivision.

Subd. 2. Administration. Positions, salary money, and nonsalary administrative money may be transferred within and between the Department of Human Services and the Department of Children, Youth, and Families as the commissioners consider necessary, with the advance approval of the commissioner of management and budget. The commissioners shall report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over health and human services finance quarterly about transfers made under this section.
