I. Summary

FY 2026 Transfers – 3rd Quarter

This report provides a list of direct appropriation transfers approved by Minnesota Management & Budget (MMB) in the third quarter of State Fiscal Year 2026. The time period included is January 1, 2026, through March 31, 2026. All transfers are general fund, unless otherwise noted. If an authority is not listed in the Transfers section, there were no transfers made using that authority during this time period.

FY 2026 Transfers – 1st and 2nd Quarter

The 1st and 2nd quarter report did not list 2025 Minn. Laws 1st Spl. Sess. Chap. 3, Art. 22, Sec. 23, Subd. 1 in the legislation requiring reporting. DCYF has made no transfers under that authority for the first two quarters of state fiscal year 2026.

II. Legislation

Laws 2025 1st Special Session, Chapter 3, Article 22, Sec 23, subd 2

Positions, salary money, and nonsalary administrative money may be transferred within the Department of Children, Youth, and Families as the commissioner deems necessary, with the advance approval of the commissioner of management and budget. The commissioner shall report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over children and families finance quarterly about transfers made under this subdivision.

Laws 2025 1st Special Session, Chapter 3, Article 22, Sec 23, subd 3

Beginning July 1, 2025, and until March 31, 2026, administrative money may be transferred between the Department of Children, Youth, and Families and the Department of Human Services or the Department of Education as the commissioners deem necessary, with the advance approval of the commissioner of management and budget. The commissioners shall report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over children and families finance and policy quarterly about transfers made under this subdivision.

Laws 2025 1st Special Session, Chapter 3, Article 20, Section 22, subd 3

Beginning July 1, 2025, and until March 31, 2026, administrative money may be transferred between the Department of Human Services and Department of Children, Youth, and Families as the commissioners deem necessary, with the advance approval of the commissioner of management and budget. The commissioners shall report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over children and families quarterly about transfers made under this section.

Minn. Stat. 142A.03 Subd. 12

Appropriation transfers to be reported. When the commissioner transfers operational money between programs under section 16A.285, in addition to the requirements of that section the commissioner must provide the chairs of the legislative committees that have jurisdiction over the agency's budget with sufficient detail to identify the account to which the money was originally appropriated, and the account to which the money is being transferred.

2024 Minn. Laws Chap. 80 Art. 1 Sec. 9

Appropriation transfers to be reported. When the commissioner transfers operational money between programs under section 16A.285, in addition to the requirements of that section the commissioner must provide the chairs of the legislative committees that have jurisdiction over the agency's budget with sufficient detail to identify the account to which the money was originally appropriated, and the account to which the money is being transferred.

Laws 2025 1st Special Session, Chapter 3, Article 22, Section 23, Subd. 1

Programs and grants. The commissioner of children, youth, and families, with the advance approval of the commissioner of management and budget, may transfer unencumbered appropriation balances for the biennium ending June 30, 2027, within fiscal years among MFIP; MFIP child care assistance under Minnesota Statutes, section 142E.08; the entitlement portion of Northstar Care for Children under Minnesota Statutes, sections 142A.60 to 142A.612; and early childhood family education under Minnesota Statutes, section 142D.11, between fiscal years of the biennium. The commissioner shall inform the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees with jurisdiction over children and families finance and policy quarterly about transfers made under this subdivision.
