Lead Service Line Replacement Program

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Overview

In recognition of the serious public health concerns from drinking water lead service lines (LSL), the state legislature created the Lead Service Line Replacement (LSLR) Program under Minnesota Statutes Section 446A.077. The program provides funding to municipalities and other public water suppliers to remove and replace lead service lines in public drinking water systems.

Jointly administered by the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) and the Public Facilities Authority (MPFA), the program is designed to coordinate with and maximize dedicated federal LSLR funds appropriated in the 2021 federal Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) for the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF).

The program combines \$243 million in state general fund dollars¹ and \$15 million of state general obligation bond dollars² with \$269 million of federal dollars from the first four (4) years of IIJA to cover public and private costs for replacing lead service lines (LSLs). Up to 10% of the state general fund and federal dollars may be used for LSL mapping and inventory activities. During state fiscal year 2026:

- MDH and the University of Minnesota coordinated to improve the [Minnesota Lead Inventory Tracking Tool](#) displaying the inventory data from community public water systems. The map is kept current to reflect completed replacement projects and updated service line inventories.
- MPFA approved the [2026 Intended Use Plan](#) (IUP) including 201 projects from 150 applicants requesting \$376M. Due to lack of funding, the IUP capped the eligible LSLR project costs at \$229M. See Appendix A for the LSLR project list from the 2026 IUP.
- MDH certified 128 new LSLR projects from the 2026 IUP to replace approximately 8,500 LSLs.
- MDH contracted with 18 engineering firms to provide inventory assistance to 342 community public water systems using a combination of federal and state dollars at a total cost of \$8,354,326.96.
- MDH approved Workforce Plans from the cities of Coon Rapids, Duluth, Minneapolis, Rochester, Saint Cloud and Saint Paul.
- MPFA awarded \$129 million through 35 contracts to 23 jurisdictions for replacement of approximately 10,000 LSLs.
- MPFA and MDH outreach included presentations at multiple conferences and training events across the state.

Program Implementation

Service Line Inventory Status

MDH continues to collect updated service line inventory data from all community public water supplies. Current data is published on the Lead Inventory Tracking Tool (LITT) at <https://maps.umn.edu/LSL/>. The data is summarized below (as of September 1, 2026):

- Total Service Lines: 1,520,219
- Non-Lead Service Lines: 1,236,913
- Service Lines of Unknown Material: 196,990
- Lead Service Lines: 86,316
 - Schools*: 44
 - Licensed Childcares*: 111

* While all LSL must be reported, some lead service lines are intended only for non-public consumption (example: sprinkler system).

Lead Service Line Inventory Technical Assistance

MDH utilized \$8,354,326 in federal and state funding to retain 18 contractors to provide technical assistance to update the service line inventory for 342 public water systems.

Lead Service Line Project Submittals

All program applicants first submit their project proposals to MDH to be listed on the drinking water Project Priority List (PPL), which identifies projects expected to proceed within the next five years. Entities whose PPL projects are scheduled for construction in the coming fiscal year submit a request to MPFA to be listed on the annual Intended Use Plan (IUP). MPFA approves the IUP in the fall.

Table 1 lists the program applicants that have submitted a project proposal to MDH to be listed on the 2026 PPL for a LSLR project.

Table 2 lists the projects funded by MPFA during state fiscal year 2026.

Appendix A includes the list of LSLR projects from the 2026 IUP that intended to proceed during the 2026 construction season.

- Part A projects were certified by MDH in fiscal year 2025.
- Part B projects intended to get certified by MDH in fiscal year 2026.

Public and Private Portions of LSLs

The drinking water service line provides the connection between the watermain in the street and each property. In most Minnesota municipalities, ownership of the service line is split between public ownership (the municipality or public utility) and private ownership (the property owner). In many cases, the line between the watermain and the curb stop (at the property line) is publicly owned and the remainder of the line is privately owned. Some municipal ordinances specify the entire service line as privately owned.

MPFA Strategy on Use of Federal and State Funds

MPFA funds LSLR projects with state appropriations and federal capitalization grants to the DWSRF appropriated through IIJA. Forty nine percent of the federal funds must be provided as “principal forgiveness” grants, the net remainder after set-aside programs must be provided as loans. MPFA awards federal loan funds at 0% interest for the publicly-owned portion of service lines and federal principal forgiveness grants for the privately-owned portion of the service line. The loan portion is paid off using state funds upon project completion.

Other Statutory Grant Priorities

MDH ensures applicants follow statutory grant priorities, which include:

- Removing lead service lines that are an imminent threat to public health and safety.
- Targeting areas with children with elevated blood lead levels.
- Targeting areas with children under the age of five.
- Targeting the removal and replacement of lead service lines that provide drinking water to schools, licensed childcare facilities, or other properties known to be used by disproportionately large numbers of children.
- Targeting areas with lower-income residents and other disadvantaged communities.
- Coordinating the replacement of publicly owned and privately owned portions of lead service lines.
- Coordinating the replacement of lead service lines with watermain replacement projects for the most efficient use of money.

Duluth has replaced all lead service lines that provide drinking water to schools and licensed childcares.

Highlights

- Due to the consistent funding provided by the Minnesota legislature, the estimated cost to replace lead service lines has stabilized and, in some cases, decreased.
- Utilizing the technical assistance contracts, Minnesota was able to identify approximately 80,000 service lines of unknown material. Even though some service lines of unknown material were identified as lead, the current replacement rate has resulted in a decrease in the number of lead service lines.
- For fiscal year 2027, MDH is providing technical assistance utilizing 18 consulting firms to provide potholing to identify service line materials for approximately 30 public water systems.
- More funding is needed. MDH estimates there are approximately 100,000 lead service lines in Minnesota. At an estimated replacement cost of \$15,000 each, the total replacement cost is estimated at \$1.5 billion.
