This letter is submitted in compliance with Minnesota Statute 299C.65, Subdivision 2, which requires the Criminal Justice Policy Group to annually identify the statutory changes and/or appropriations necessary to ensure efficient and effective operation of criminal justice information systems.

After consulting with the Executive Director of the CrimNet Office, the Criminal Justice Policy Group recommends a single statutory change which has been incorporated in Governor Ventura's domestic terrorism bill. The change will allow the release of all juvenile records to criminal justice professionals, a change important to the integration of all criminal justice data.
