#### THE BUDGET DOCUMENTS

The 1975-77 Biennial Budget is presented in four parts: the "Budget Address," the "Fund Statements," the "Detailed Estimates," and the "Capital Outlay Budget."

The large document containing the detailed estimates is intended as a workbook primarily for the use of the Senate Finance and House Appropriations Committees. It includes the Governor's budget recommendations for each account requiring a "direct appropriation." A direct appropriation is defined as one made for a definite amount and period of time. In addition, a listing of Open and Standing appropriations are included to give the reader the detail of all the general fund requirements, even though these accounts do not require legislative action.

This document contains a statement for each fund or group of funds. The total of receipts and expenditures from all funds is presented in the "Summary of Fund Statements."

Included in the detail estimates are budgets for eleven departments which are expressed in terms of services provided. These departments are: Administration, Agriculture, Commerce, Education, Finance, Health, Natural Resources, Personnel, Public Service, Public Welfare, and the State Planning Agency. The material for these departments is printed on pink paper.

The first page preceding the detail presented for most other departments is an activity summary. This is printed on blue paper and expresses the total department requests in terms of services provided. For comparative information, this same data is also summarized by appropriation and by source of funds.
