Clause a: GENERAL STATEMENT OF BOARD ACTIVITIES

This description should cover both FY 81 and FY 82 and include any changes (additions/deletions) in activities between those years.

During this biennium, 157 applicants were licensed at the Licensed Consulting Psychologist level and 245 at the Licensed Psychologist level, compared with the previous biennium's figures of 139 and 140 respectively. The total of 402 for this biennium represents an increase of 43 per cent over the total for the 1979-1980 biennium.

Four objective examinations were held at which 386 applicants were examined, an increase of 26 per cent over the 1979-180 biennium.

Of the 245 licensed as Licensed Consulting Psychologists, 37 were licensed with waiver of examination because of successful performance for this licensure when examined prior to licensure as Licensed Psychologists, and 18 were licensed with waiver of examination because of successful performance on the examination, according to Minnesota standards, in other states. Five Licensed Psychologists were licensed with waiver of examination because of successful performance in other states.

Biennial licenses were renewed by 731 Licensed Consulting Psychologists and 295 Licensed Psychologists.

A public hearing was held in FY 1982 on the proposed new rules which instituted a new licensure procedure, provided a new set of Rules of Conduct, and updated the remaining provisions. The new Rules were adopted by the Board on June 25, 1982. The proposed rule on continuing education was not finalized because of intense concentration on the revision of existing rules.

Disciplinary activity included imposition of conditional licenses on 5 licensees, restricted licenses on 2 licensees, stayed indefinite suspensions on 2 licensees. All were settled by means of conference and all were uncontested. One hearing was held regarding suspension of licenses based upon non payment of renewal fees. As a result, 30 licenses were suspended. At the close of the biennium, formal suspension was initiated regarding non payment of renewal fees for an additional 15 licenses.

Clause f: BRIEF SUMMARY OF BOARD RULES PROPOSED OR ADOPTED DURING THIS REPORTING PERIOD, FY 81 AND FY 82. GIVE APPROPRIATE CITATIONS TO THE STATE REGISTER AND PUBLISHED RULES FOR THOSE ADOPTED.

On June 25, 1982, the Board of Psychology adopted new rules, 7 MCAR SS 10.001-10.009. The Proposed Rules were printed in the State Register of 2/22/82, Vol. 6, No. 35. The amendments were printed in the State Register on 8/2/82, Vol. 7, No. 5.

The new rules provided a two-step procedure for licensure - application for admission to examination and application for licensure - which permits applicants to sit for the objective examination (EPPP) after completing education requirements but before completing employment requirements. Since the exam is administered only twice each year, the new procedure eliminates the waiting period between date of completion of employment requirements and date of next examination.

Changes were also made in supervision requirements for the pre-licensure employment, and in the endorsement procedure.

The other major change is in the Rules of Conduct which supersedes the Code of Ethics (Psych 10). The new rules spell out more precisely conduct which is unethical, making it easier for licensees and consumers of psychological services to determine whether behavior is within ethical bounds.

The remaining rules were revised and updated without major policy changes, to make them less ambiguous and easier to comprehend.

Activity related to licensure increased tremendously during this biennium compared with the previous biennium. Both the number of applicants sitting for the objective examination and the number of licensees of other states seeking licensure with waiver of the examination has markedly increased. It is anticipated that the number of persons sitting for the examination will surge during the next year or so, due to the change in the rules, and then level off.

Verification of licensure to other states for licensees moving out of Minnesota has remained essentially static, as has verification for insurance reimbursement, the latter because of the availability of up-to-date licensee lists.

Telephone inquiries now average over 5,000 per year, and range from licensure verification through qualifications of licensees to requirements for licensure. Between 50 and 100 calls per year involve complaints, but not all result in the filing of written complaints.

Efforts are continuing to redesign forms and office procedures to enable the present staff (two persons) to keep up with the workload without resorting to adding another part-or-full time staff person.
