ABOUT THIS SUMMARY

Reported in this summary is the total amount of cash on hand January 1, 1982, campaign contributions received, public financing received, campaign expenditures made in 1982, and cash on hand December 31, 1982, for principal campaign committees of candidates for election in 1982 to state executive, legislative and judicial offices.

Campaign expenditure limit (\$1,270,800 governor-lieutenant governor; \$211,800 attorney general; \$105,900 Secretary of state, state auditor, state treasurer; \$31,770 state senator; \$15,885 state representative) is in effect only for those candidates who signed a public financing agreement or tax credit agreement or both in 1982; in addition, a 20% increase in the stated limit is permitted for a winning candidate in a contested primary who received less than twice the number of votes of the nearest competitor.

Major donors contributing in aggregate in 1982 in excess of \$50 (to legislative and district and county court candidates) and \$100 (to statewide candidates) will be listed in Part II of this summary, to be available later this year.

Editor's Note:

Legislative Reapportionment - The 1982 election was the first election for state senator and state representative after the reapportionment of legislative districts based upon the 1980 federal census in Minnesota. The 1982 reapportionment changed the boundaries of legislative districts which were in existence from 1972 election through the 1980 election. New numbers were assigned in some areas of the state. Some of the individuals were serving in a legislative district at the time they filed for election in one of the newly-drawn 1982 legislative districts.

In this publication, any individual who was serving in state elective office in July, 1982 and who filed for election in 1982 is designated by an asterisk (*).

Based on reports filed by these individuals' committees:

- 164 sought election;
- 145 signed public financing agreements;
- 23 won election in a district in which the opponent outspent the individual;
- 5 lost election in a district in which the individual outspent the opponent.

ABOUT CAMPAIGN FINANCE DISCLOSURE

Purpose

- . To provide the public with information about where the money comes from and where the money goes in financing campaigns;
- . To limit the overall spending for elections by candidates accepting public financing;
- . To reduce the reliance of candidates on large contributors.

Program

- . Registration and reporting of receipts and expenditures by political committees and funds to influence the nomination or election of candidates for governor, lieutenant governor, attorney general, secretary of state, state auditor, state treasurer, state legislator, and elective judgeships, and to promote or defeat state ballot questions;
- . Public disclosure of sources of contributions to political committees and funds;
- . Limits on contributions to candidates for partisan office;
- . Limits on campaign expenditures by the principal campaign committee of a candidate who accepts public financing.

ABOUT THE ETHICAL PRACTICES BOARD

Purpose

- . To maintain public confidence in the integrity of government through public disclosure and public financing of candidates through administration of the Ethics in Government Act, Minn. Stat. Ch. 10A.

Members

- . Six member citizen body;
- . Appointed by the governor; confirmed by a 3/5th vote of both houses of the legislature;
- . One former legislator of each major party;
- . Two individuals who have not been a public official nor a political party officer in the last three years;
- . No more than three members of the same political party.

A candidate for state executive, legislative, or judicial office who accepts more than \$100 from sources other than the candidate's own personal funds is required to register a principal campaign committee with the Ethical Practices Board. However, a candidate who does not designate and form a principal campaign committee and who spends in excess of \$100 of his own money, not including filing fee, to influence his nomination or election is required to file a Report of Receipts and Expenditures with the Board.
