ABOUT POLITICAL COMMITTEES AND POLITICAL FUNDS Definitions Political CommitteeAny political party; any association of two or more persons whose major purpose is to support or oppose the nomination or election of candidates for state executive, state legislative, state judicial offices, or to promote or defeat a state ballot question. Political FundAny accumulation of dues or voluntary contributions by an association other than a political committee which is collected or expended for the purpose of influencing the nomination or election of candidates for state executive, state legislative, elective judicial offices, or to promote or defeat a state ballot question. Who Reports The treasurer of a registered political committee or political fund. An individual who makes independent expenditures in excess of \$100, in aggregate, in a calendar year. Reports are filed with the Ethical Practices Board.
A registered committee or fund must file a report even if there has been no activity within the reporting period.

#### ABOUT CAMPAIGN FINANCE DISCLOSURE

#### Purpose

- . To provide the public with information about where the money comes from and where the money goes in financing campaigns;
- . To limit the overall spending for elections by candidates accepting public financing;
- . To reduce the reliance of candidates on large contributors.

#### Program

- . Registration and reporting of receipts and expenditures by political committees and funds to influence the nomination or election of candidates for governor, lieutenant governor, attorney general, secretary of state, state auditor, state treasurer, state legislator, and elective judgeships, and to promote or defeat state ballot questions;
- . Public disclosure of sources of contributions to political committees and funds;
- . Limits on contributions to candidates for partisan office;
- . Limits on campaign expenditures by the principal campaign committee of a candidate who accepts public financing.

#### Purpose

• To maintain public confidence in the integrity of government through public disclosure and public financing of candidates through administration of the Ethics in Government Act, *Minn. Stat. Ch. 10A.* 

#### Members

- . Six member citizen body;
- Appointed by the governor; confirmed by a 3/5th vote of both houses of the legislature;
- One former legislator of each major party;
- . Two individuals who have not been a public official nor a political party officer in the last three years;
- . No more than three members of the same political party.

Campaign Finance Summary 1982: Principal Campaign Committees of Candidates for State Office, Part I, Total Receipts and Expenditures is available now from the Board office. Major donors contributing in aggregate to these committees in 1982 in excess of \$50 (to legislative district and county court candidates) and \$200 and over (to statewide candidates) will be listed in Part II of this summary, to be available later this year.

#### Campaign Finance Summary: Candidates (Other than those running for office in 1982)

The principal campaign committee of a state candidate continues to report annually to the Board until the committee terminates. These committees include candidates for election since 1974. The most recent reports were filed January 31, 1983, for calendar year 1982. Information about these candidate committees is available at the Board office in summary and in filed reports.

#### Public Viewing and Copying

All statements and reports filed with the Board are available for public viewing and photocopying at cost within 48 hours of receipt in the Board office, 41 State Office Building, St. Paul, MN 55155; telephone (612) 296-5148.

Copies of statements and reports filed by legislators and candidates for the legislature are filed by the Board with the auditor of each county within the legislative district. These copies are available for public inspection and copying at cost within 48 hours after receip in the county auditor's office.
