Clause a: GENERAL STATEMENT OF BOARD ACTIVITIES

This description should cover both FY 83 and FY 84 and include any changes (additions/deletions) in activities between those years.

In August, 1982, the Board formally adopted a new set of rules which replaced those adopted shortly after the Board was created by the legislature in 1973. The new rules embodied two major changes: a) applicants for licensure for the first time were permitted to sit for the objective examination after obtaining the degree upon which licensure would be based, rather than waiting until the two years of post-degree employment had been completed; and b) Rules of Conduct to replace the Code of Ethics which essentially was the Code of Ethics of the American Psychological Association as it existed in 1974.

The first change has altered administration of the Board's responsibilities considerably. New forms had to be devised, new procedures tried and revised as the process evolved, and, most important, the work load gradually spread more evenly throughout the year, as applicants become aware of the change, sit for the exam after obtaining the degree, then apply for licensure when they have completed the employment requirements. Under the old system licensure was bunched in December and June, following the October and April objective examinations.

The second change has resulted in a sharp increase in the number of complaints being submitted, due largely to the new requirements that licensees either post the client bill of rights and the licensee's areas of competence in their waiting rooms or make them available as handouts, and that licensees must report certain rules violations on the part of other licensees. Both changes have increased clients' awareness of what kinds of behavior may be violations of rule and how to file a complaint, and licensees' awareness of problem areas among their colleagues.

While the new rules did not change the education requirements for licensure except in minor ways, there has been an increasing awareness throughout the biennium on the part of persons with degrees from other departments than psychology that they may be eligible for licensure. The result has been a steady increase in the number of applicants with degrees which require Board evaluation before admission to the examination. This, in turn, has increased the Board's workload to a measurable extent.

Clause f: BRIEF SUMMARY OF BOARD RULES PROPOSED OR ADOPTED DURING THIS REPORTING PERIOD, FY 83 AND FY 84. GIVE APPROPRIATE CITATIONS TO THE STATE REGISTER AND PUBLISHED RULES FOR THOSE ADOPTED.

On June 25, 1982, the Board of Psychology adopted new rules, 7 MCAR SS 10.001-10.009. The Proposed Rules were printed in the State Register of 2/22/82, Vol. 6, No. 35. The amendments were printed in the State Register on 8/2/82, Vol. 7, No. 5. Effective date of new Rules: 8/7/82.

The new rules provided a two-step procedure for licensure - application for admission to examination and application for licensure - which permits applicants to sit for the objective examination (EPPP) after completing education requirements but before completing employment requirements. Since the exam is administered only twice each year, the new procedure eliminates the waiting period between date of completion of employment requirements and date of next examination.

Changes were also made in supervision requirements for the pre-licensure employment, and in the endorsement procedure.

The other major change is in the Rules of Conduct which supersedes the Code of Ethics (Psych 10). The new rules spell out more precisely conduct which is unethical, making it easier for licensees and consumers of psychological services to determine whether behavior is within ethical bounds.

The remaining rules were revised and updated without major policy changes, to make them less ambiguous and easier to comprehend.

Explanation of "NOT LIC" column on preceding pages:

Because of the change in procedures resulting from the Rules adopted in August, 1982, applicants may sit for the objective examination immediately after obtaining the degree upon which licensure is to be based. As a result, for many applicants it will be two years or more after sitting for the objective examination before they have completed the required two years of post-degree employment (or its equivalent in part-time employment) and may apply for licensure.

The column marked "NOT LIC" represents applicants who have not yet applied for licensure as well as those who have failed the examination. In other words, it includes all applicants who have not to date completed the license application procedure.

It would appear that licensure data pertaining to applicants examined in FY 83 and FY 84 will have to be included in the next biennial report in order to give a more complete picture of what is happening in the licensure process.

It appeared to be appropriate not to include a separate column indicating numbers who failed the objective examination, since applicants who do so may sit for the examination as many times as they wish, without penalty or restriction, and may apply for licensure when finally passing the examination. The number "not licensed" appeared to have more relevance for the purposes of this report than the number "not passing".

Should the number "not passing" be of value, the data can easily be provided.
