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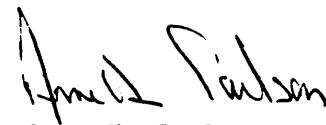


## P R E F A C E

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## General Summary

### SCOPE

This report presents financial data on the 87 counties in Minnesota for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1985. The data in this report were generated from the audited annual financial statements of the counties and from Department of Revenue reports of levies and valuations. All counties reported their governmental funds on the modified accrual basis of accounting during 1985.

### OPERATIONS

A comparative summary of revenues, expenditures, and outstanding indebtedness of the counties for the years 1981 through 1985 is presented in Table 1. Governmental revenues and expenditures reported in Tables 2 and 3 include the general fund and other governmental funds. Cash purchases, sales of investments, and the trust and agency funds are not included in the report. County hospitals and nursing homes are considered public service enterprises and their financial operations are presented in separate tables. Population figures are based on the 1985 population estimates of the State Demographer.

Counties serve as agents for other governmental units in the collection and distribution of taxes and grants, in addition to their governmental functions. As agency funds, these monies are not included in the report.

### REVENUES

Revenues of county governmental funds totaled \$1.98 billion in 1985, which is \$144.6 million or 7.9% higher than in 1984. The two main sources of county revenues are property taxes and intergovernmental revenues, which together accounted for 84.2% of total revenues in 1985. Over the past five years the percentage of revenues from taxes has increased from 28.9% in 1981 to 31.5% in 1985. Intergovernmental revenues have declined from 56.1% in 1981 to 52.7% in 1985. During this five year-period the amount of taxes collected increased from \$419.6 million to \$622.7 million, and intergovernmental revenues increased from \$812.6 million to \$1.04 billion.

### EXPENDITURES

Expenditures by counties for governmental functions in 1985 totaled \$1.97 billion, which is an increase of \$176.1 million or 9.8% over 1984. The increase in five years is \$572.4 million, or 41.1%.

Most of the increase over the five years from 1981 to 1985 came from Human Services, which rose \$248.3 million. Public safety expenditures rose \$56.5 million, highway expenditures increased \$111.0 million, and general government rose \$75.7 million during the last five years.

**Human Services is the largest county function, accounting for 45.7% of the total expenditures in 1985.**

Tables of revenues and expenditures do not include direct welfare payments for the counties by state and federal governments. Six counties do not report detailed welfare expenditures. The six comprise two welfare districts and report all expenditures in the "Other Welfare Costs" category. Consequently, the detail of welfare expenditures is presented for reference purposes only. Lincoln, Lyon and Murray counties comprise the Region VIII North Welfare Board and the counties of Faribault, Martin and Watonwan form the Faribault, Martin and Watonwan Human Services Board.

#### **OPERATIONS OF PUBLIC SERVICE ENTERPRISES**

The financial operations of county hospitals, nursing homes, and other service enterprises are presented in Tables 5, 6 and 7.

The 15 county hospitals had operating revenues of \$155.5 million and operating expenses of \$169.4 million, resulting in an operating loss of \$13.9 million.

The 19 county nursing homes had operating revenues of \$42.0 million and operating expenses of \$42.1 million. The operating loss was \$85.0 thousand; however, nonoperating revenues brought net income to \$1.4 million for this period, compared to \$1.2 million for the prior year.

Twenty-nine counties are shown with other public service enterprise funds, including nursing services, sanitary landfills, ambulance service, and others. In this category, operating revenues totaled \$12.0 million, and operating expenses totaled \$15.2 million, resulting in an operating loss of \$3.2 million. Nonoperating revenues of \$6.9 million has raised net income to \$3.1 million.

#### INDEBTEDNESS

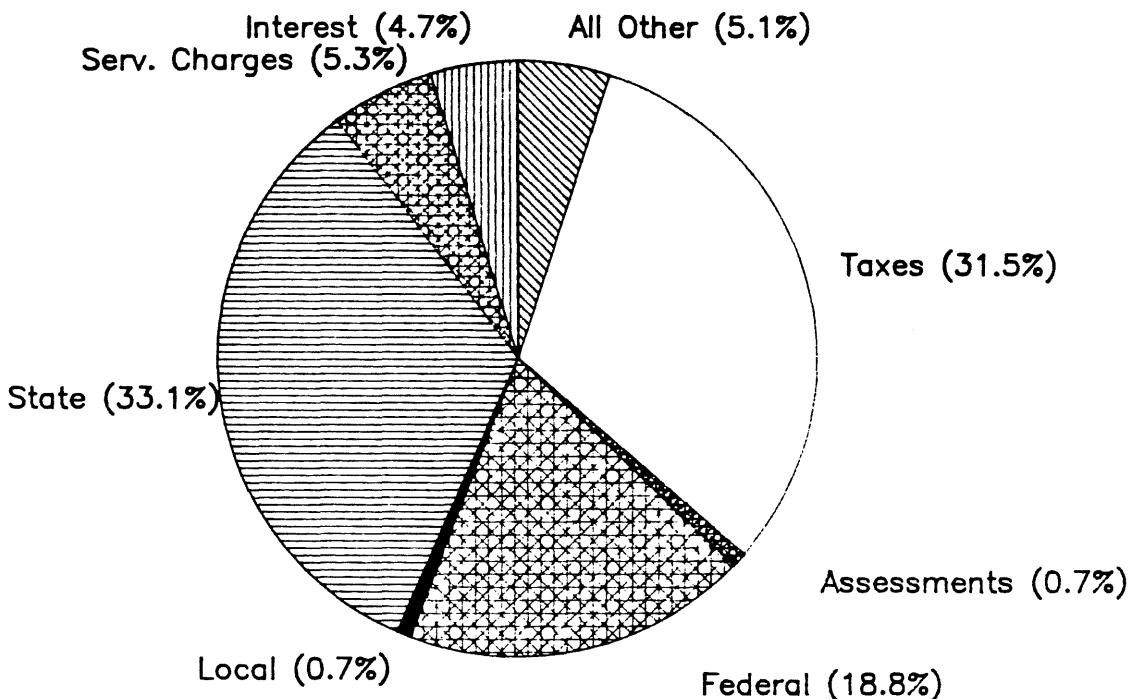
Outstanding bonded debt of the counties, as shown in Table 4, was \$433.5 million at the end of 1985, an increase of \$85.8 million over 1984. Olmsted County issued general obligation revenue bonds for the Human Service Campus (former Rochester State Hospital) totaling \$41.6 million and Waste to Energy Facility totaling \$24.9 million.

In 1985 the counties issued bonds totaling \$110.3 million and retired bonds totaling \$21.7 million, leaving \$433.5 million outstanding at December 31, 1985. Liabilities for compensated absences totaled \$73.5 million, and other long-term debt totaled \$27.3 million; these are also presented in Table 4.

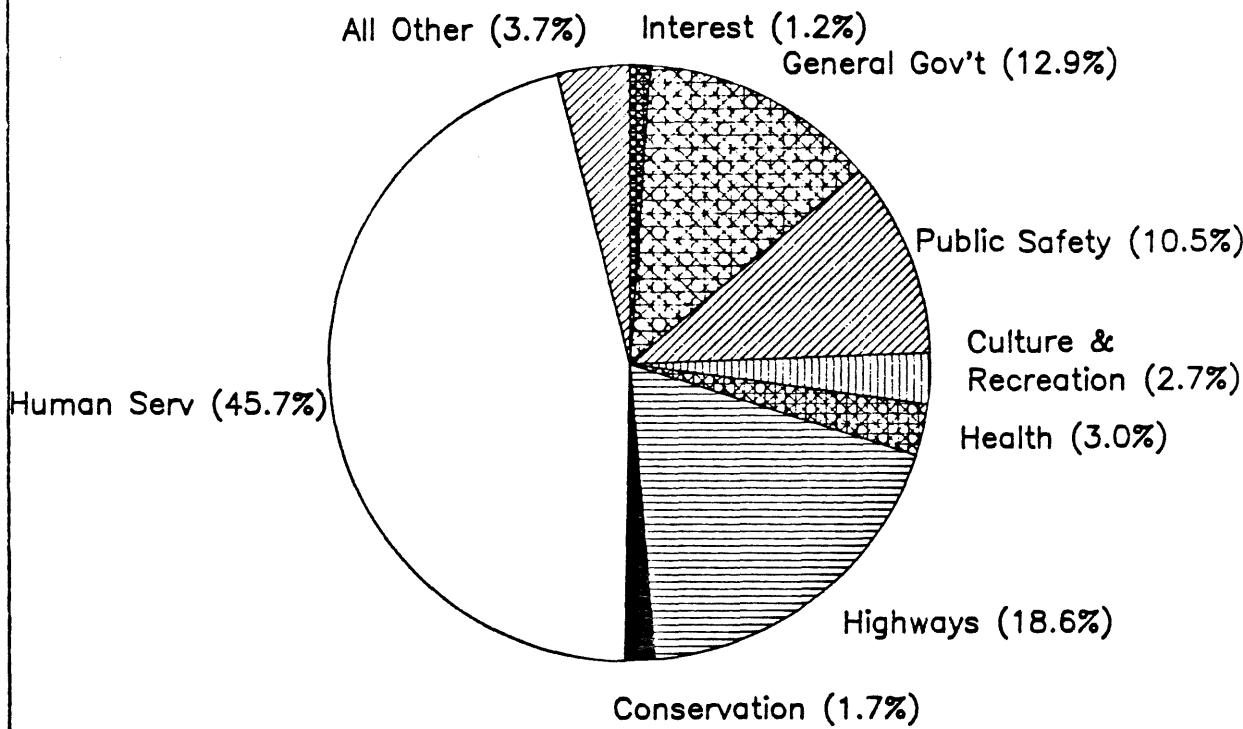


**REVENUES, EXPENDITURES, AND DEBT

THE COUNTIES**

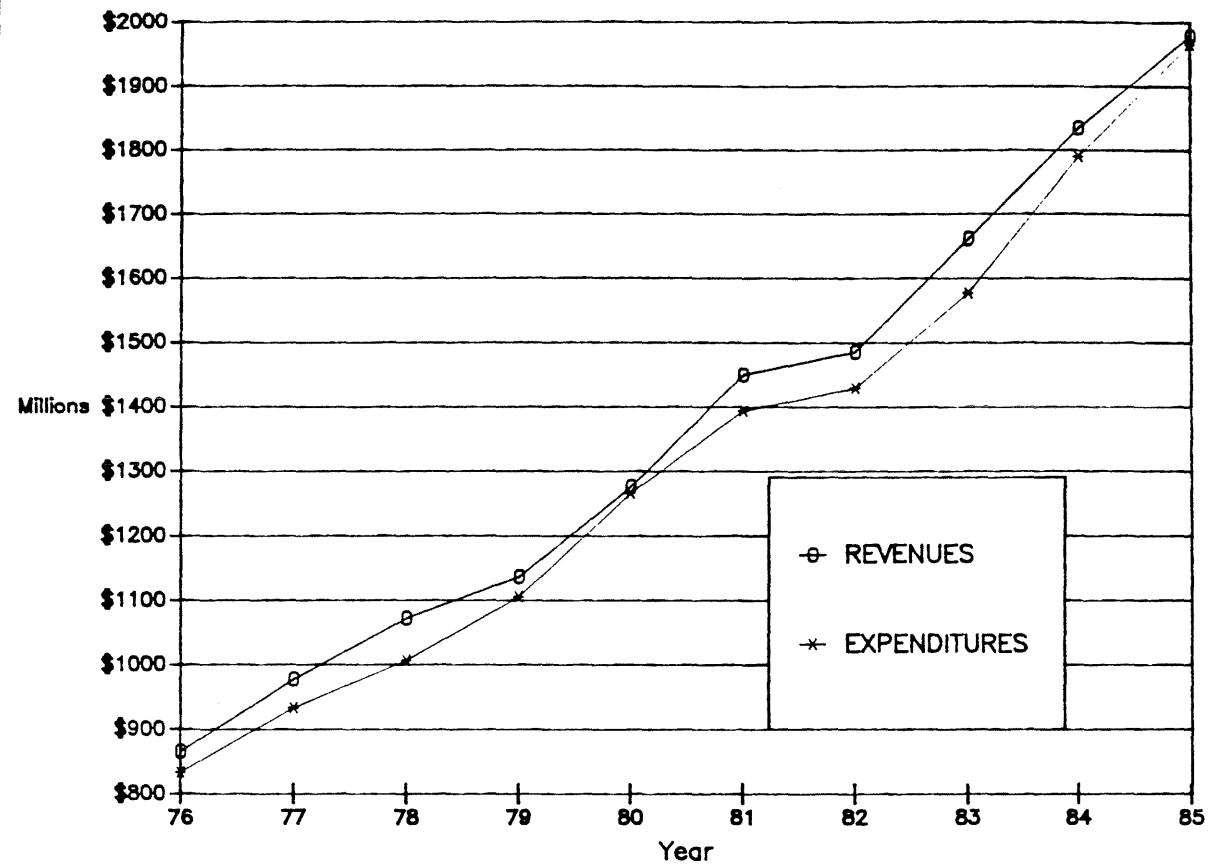
**FIGURE 1**

**\$1,979,043,866**



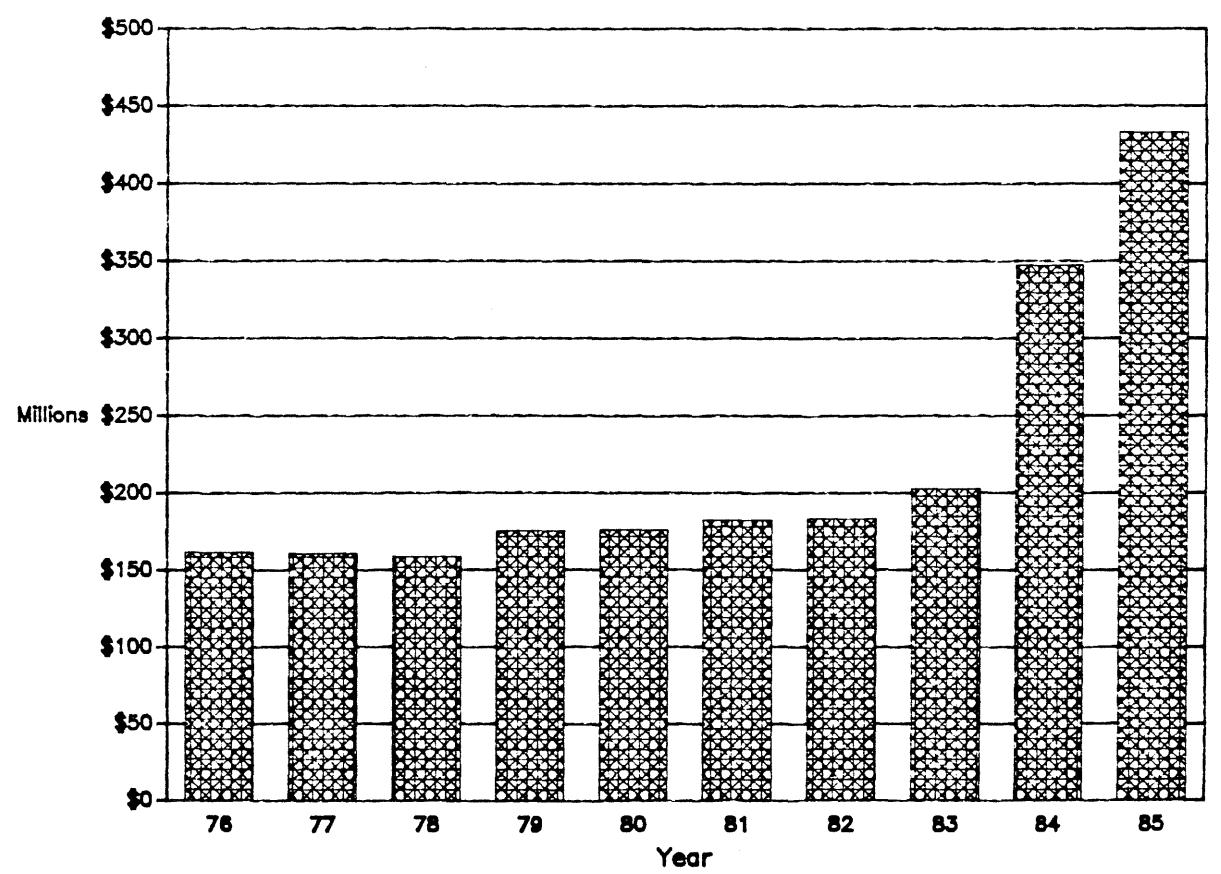
**FIGURE 2**
