SECTION 7 - TECHNICAL NOTES

- 1. SUBSTITUTE AND ADOPTIVE CARE INVENTORY DATA FOR CALENDAR YEARS 1983 THROUGH 1984 WAS COLLECTED THROUGH BASICALLY THE SAME REPORT FORM AND THROUGH TWO PRIMARY MODES OF SUBMISSION.
- 2. THE TWO MODES OF SUBMISSION ARE:
 - A. DATA SUBMITTED ON DISK TO COMPUTER SYSTEMS SUPPORT IN ST CLOUD FOLLOWED BY DIRECT TRANSMITTAL TO STATE MAIN FRAME WITH ACCESS THROUGH SEVERAL PROGRAMS.
 - B. DATA SUBMITTED ON STATE PROVIDED PAPER FORMS WHICH ARE KEYED BY DATA ENTRY AND MERGED INTO THE DATA BASE CREATED FROM A. ABOVE.
- 3. SUPPLEMENTAL REPORTS (ALL PAPER) HAVE BEEN ADDED TO COLLECT ADDITIONAL DATA (e.g. RACE OF FOSTER PARENTS COMPARED TO RACE OF BLACK AND INDIAN CHILDREN IN FOSTER FAMILY HOMES.) IN GENERAL THIS DATA HAS BEEN MANAGED IN PC (PERSONAL COMPUTER) LOTUS AND DBASE FILES RATHER THAN MERGING WITH PRIMARY DATA BASE FROM THE INVENTORY. FOSTER PARENT'S RACE DATA CANNOT BE ADDED TO THE INVENTORY ITSELF UNTIL AND UNLESS DATA FOSTER PARENT'S RACE DATA IS ADDED TO THE COUNTIES' DATA BASES.
- 4. DATA FOR 1981 WAS SUBMITTED ENTIRELY ON PAPER REPORTS. IN GENERAL THE INFORMATION INDICATED AS N.A. ON THE PRECEDING TABLES WAS INFORMATION THAT WAS NOT REQUESTED.
- 5. DATA FOR 1979 WAS DERIVED FROM OTHER REPORTING SOURCES (PRIMARILY CLAIMS FOR FOSTER CARE REIMBURSEMENT) RATHER THAN FROM A SPECIFIC ANNUAL REPORT DESIGNED FOR THIS PURPOSE. THIS ACCOUNTS FOR BOTH MISSING INFORMATION AND INFORMATION THAT WAS NOT COMPARABLE FROM YEAR TO YEAR.
- 6. BREAKDOWNS FOR A FEW ITEMS EVEN OF THE INVENTORY FORMS (e.g. LEGAL STATUS) HAVE CHANGED ENOUGH TO LOSE COMPARABILITY FROM OLDER YEARS.
- 7. FOR 1985 THE ANALYSIS OF THE SEPARATE REPORT BY RACE OF THE FOSTER PARENTS FOR BLACK AND INDIAN CHILDREN WAS PERFORMED TOO LONG AFTER THE ANALYSIS OF THE SEPARATE INVENTORIES FOR BLACK AND INDIAN CHILDREN TO OBTAIN IDENTICAL COUNTS FOR MANY ITEMS FROM EVERY COUNTY.
- B. FOR 1984 THE SEPARATE INVENTORIES FOR BLACK AND INDIAN CHILDREN WERE COLLECTED FOR FEBRUARY 1985 RATHER THAN AS OF 12/31/84.
- 9. COUNTS ON WHICH THE PERCENTS IN THE SUMMARY TABLES ARE BASED ARE AVAILABLE IN A PRINT OUT OF A LOTUS FILE. TO OBTAIN THESE CONTACT DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES, SOCIAL SERVICES DIVISION, OPERATIONS SECTION.
