2. NURSING EDUCATION

In accordance with Minnesota Statutes section 148.251 and 148.292 the Board approved schools of nursing (nursing education programs) which prepare persons for licensure as either a registered nurse or a licensed practical nurse.

1. Allegations: A male licensed practical nurse improperly bathed the perineal area of hospitalized female patients unable to communicate.
2. Although nurse denied improper touching while bathing the patients, investigation found many practice deficits.
3. Board activities: Scheduled conference (no show); scheduled pre-hearing conference (no show); attorney negotiation; accepted Settlement Stipulation and Consent Order
4. Disposition: Consent Order of Indefinite Suspension.
5. Reason for Disposition: Although the nurse denied the improper bathing of female patients, the Board found many practice deficits that warranted the nurse's removal from practice.

CASE B - Pending from Previous Fiscal Year

1. Allegations: A male licensed practical nurse used his access to a female psychiatric patient's records and the therapeutic relationship to develop a sexual relationship with the patient during her hospitalization.
2. Investigation supported the allegations, although the nurse denied them.
3. Board activities: Scheduled conference (no show); scheduled pre-hearing conference and hearing (no show); Administrative Law Judge recommended disciplinary action be taken; Hearing record presented to full Board for review.
4. Disposition: Order of Revocation of License.
5. Reason for Disposition: The seriousness of the sexual conduct, the nurse's inability to establish professional behavior boundaries, and the credible and unrefuted testimony of the patient at the hearing.

1. Allegations: A wheelchair bound male nursing home patient alleged that a male licensed practical nurse invited the patient to the nurse's apartment and the nurse refused to allow the patient to leave until the patient participated in an unspecified sex act.
