The information in this report was compiled from Board records by office staff.

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
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GENERAL STATEMENT OF BOARD ACTIVITIES

The Minnesota Board of Chiropractic Examiners (MBCE) relocated in the Colonial Office Building, 2700 University Avenue West, Suite 20, St. Paul, Minnesota in November, 1987.

The office was reorganized and two new personnel hired: 1) Management Analyst I, and 2) Committee Coordinator. See organizational chart:



A Peer Review Committee was formed by the Board and seven committee members were appointed. The Peer Review Committee is currently operational, and is a pioneer committee in the State of Minnesota which reviews health care. Minnesota is the second state in the nation to establish such a peer review committee.

The MBCE has purchased computer equipment and is installing new procedures to modernize daily operations. This process will continue during the next few years.

A new law was drafted and presented to the Legislature and signed on June 1, 1987. This law created the Peer Review Committee, and outlined greater regulation and enforcement of the chiropractic profession.

The MBCE is to ensure qualified and competent Doctors of Chiropractic practicing in Minnesota. In order to meet this objective, the Board's activities also involved: testing applicants for licensure; licensing applicants who meet all requirements; renewing registration of existing licensees; processing complaints; approving programs for continuing education; registering professional coroprations; and peer review.

NUMBER OF PERSONS EXAMINED BY THE BOARD

I. Fiscal Year 1987

The Minnesota Board of Chiropractic Examiners administered the Board Examination to 166 Minnesota residents, and to 42 non-Minnesota residents in fiscal year 1987. As a result of the examination process licenses were issued to 140 Minnesota residents, and 23 licenses issued non-Minnesota residents. Licenses were not issued to 26 Minnesota residents or to 19 non-Minnesota residents who took the examination. (For specifics, refer to tables 4 and 5.)

The Minnesota Board of Chiropractic Examiners did not, during the course of fiscal year 1987, issue or grant a license to any person not taking the Board's examination.

II. Fiscal Year 1988

The Minnesota Board of Chiropractic Examiners administered the Board Examination to 112 Minnesota residents, and to 42 non-Minnesota residents in fiscal year 1988. As a result of the examination process licenses were issued to 85 Minnesota residents, and 22 licenses issued to non-Minnesota residents. Licenses were not issued to 27 Minnesota residents, or to 20 non-Minnesota residents who took the examination. (For specifics, refer to tables 4 and 5.)

The Minnesota Board of Chiropractic Examiners did not, during the course of fiscal year 1988, issue or grant a license to any person not taking the Board's examination.
