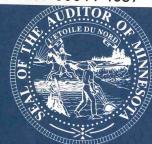




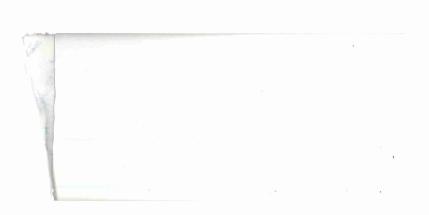
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## MINNESOTA OFFICE OF THE STATE AUDITOR

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The Office of the State Auditor is a Constitutional office which provides a post-audit function for local governmental units. The Office attests to the fairness of these financial statements as well as to their compliance with applicable laws and regulations.

In general, the Office facilitates improved financial management practices within the State through its oversight programs and contributes to the ongoing economic education of public officials and taxpayers.

The State Auditor has financial oversight for over 4400 local units of government. The local units of government include the following:

- 1800 townships
- 855 cities
- 517 educational districts
- 87 counties
- 700 police and fire relief association funds
- 150 housing and redevelopment authorities
- 22 port authorities
- 91 soil and water conservation districts
- 144 (approximate) special districts

The State auditor also maintains a data base of financial information on local governments. The data are collected by the Financial Health Program which assesses long-term trends for cities and counties.

The State Auditor serves on the State's Executive Council, Land Exchange Board, State Investment Board, State Housing Finance Agency, Rural Finance Administration Board, and the Public Employees Retirement Association Board.

The annual report of the State Auditor covers the revenues, expenditures, indebtedness, taxable valuations and tax levies of the counties in Minnesota for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1988. Populations were taken from "Minnesota Populations, 1988" from the Office of the State Demographer. This information has been collected and is published and distributed pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Sections 6.74 and 6.75.

The Office of the State Auditor has generated this report using d.BASE IV and IBM PS/2's. Anyone who wishes to analyze the data further, including receiving a copy on diskettes, should contact this office for assistance.

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#### GENERAL SUMMARY

#### SCOPE

This report presents financial data on the 87 counties in Minnesota for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1988. The data in this report were generated from the audited annual financial statements of the counties and from Department of Revenue reports of levies and valuations. All counties reported on the modified accrual basis of accounting during 1988 for their governmental funds.

#### **OPERATIONS**

A comparative summary of revenues, expenditures, and bonded debt of the counties for the years 1985 through 1988 is presented in Table 1. Governmental revenues and expenditures reported in Tables 2 and 3 include the general fund and all other governmental funds. County hospitals and nursing homes are considered public service enterprises and their financial operations are presented in separate tables. Population figures are based on the 1988 population estimates from the Office of the State Demographer.

Counties serve as agents for other governmental units in the collection and distribution of taxes and grants, in addition to their governmental functions.

#### REVENUES

Revenues of county governmental funds totaled \$2.34 billion in 1988, which is \$187.3 million or 8.7% higher than in 1987. The two main sources of county revenues are property taxes and intergovernmental revenues, which together accounted for 83.8% of total revenues in 1988. Over the past five years the percentage of revenues from taxes has increased from 31.6% in 1984 to 36.0% in 1988. Intergovernmental revenues percentage has declined from 53.1% in 1984 to 47.8% in 1988. During this five year-period the amount of taxes collected increased from \$580.1 million to \$843.6 million, and intergovernmental revenues increased from \$973.6 million to \$1.12 billion.

#### **EXPENDITURES**

Expenditures by counties for governmental functions in 1988 totaled \$2.36 billion, which is a increase of \$218.2 million, or 10.2% greater than 1987. The increase in five years is \$575.4 million, or 32.2%. Most of the increase over the five years from 1984 to 1988 came from Human Services, which rose \$268.5 million. Public safety expenditures rose \$71.5 million, highway expenditures increased \$59.2 million, and general government rose \$80.4 million during the last five years.

Human Services is the largest county function, accounting for 52.5% of the total current expenditures in 1988.

Tables of revenues and expenditures do not include direct welfare payments for the counties by state and federal governments. Six counties do not report detailed welfare expenditures. These six comprise two welfare districts and report all expenditures in the "Other Welfare Costs" category. Consequently, the detail of welfare expenditures is presented for reference purposes only. Lincoln, Lyon and Murray counties comprise the Region VIII North Welfare Board and the counties of Faribault, Martin, and Watonwan form the Faribault-Martin-Watonwan Human Services Board.

#### OPERATIONS OF PUBLIC SERVICE ENTERPRISES

The financial operations of county hospitals, nursing homes, and other county service enterprises are presented in Tables 5, 6 and 7.

The 15 county hospitals had operating revenues of \$199.4 million and operating expenses of \$210.9 million, resulting in an operating loss of \$11.5 million. The non-operating revenues of Hennepin county (\$13.1 million primarily in taxes and grants) and the other counties, resulted in a net income of \$2.9 million.

The counties operated 17 nursing homes during 1988. The results of operation for 15 of the nursing homes are shown on Table 6. Two nursing homes include their operations with the county hospital operations. The county nursing homes had operating revenues of \$37.7 million and operating expenses of \$40.7 million. Net operating loss was \$3.0 million; however, non-operating revenues brought the net loss to \$1.7 million for this period, compared to a net loss of \$1.1 million for the prior year.

Thirty-one counties operate 47 other public service enterprise funds, including nursing services, and sanitary landfills. In this category, operating revenues totaled \$30.0 million, and operating expenses totaled \$35.2 million, resulting in an operating loss of \$5.3 million. Non-operating revenues increased net income to a profitable \$4.7 million.

The following is a two-year summary of operations for public service enterprises:

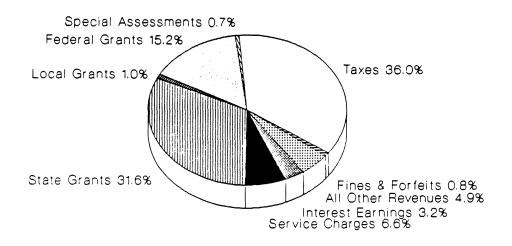

#### INDEBTEDNESS

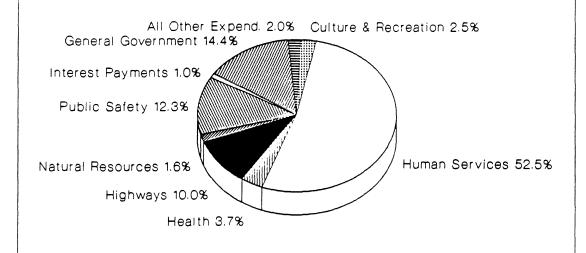
Outstanding bonded debt of the counties, as shown in Table 4, was \$398.5 million at the end of 1988, an increase of \$60.3 million from 1987. Twenty-six counties issued bonds during 1988 totaling \$87.2 million as compared to 26 counties issuing \$64.9 million in 1987.

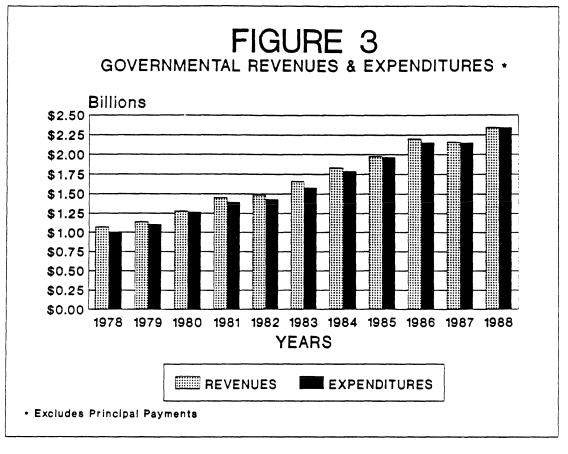
In 1988 the counties issued bonds totaling \$87.2 million and retired bonds totaling \$29.5 million, leaving \$398.5 million outstanding at December 31, 1988. Liabilities for compensated absences totaled \$94.6 million, and other long-term debt totaled \$80.8 million; these are also presented in Table 4.

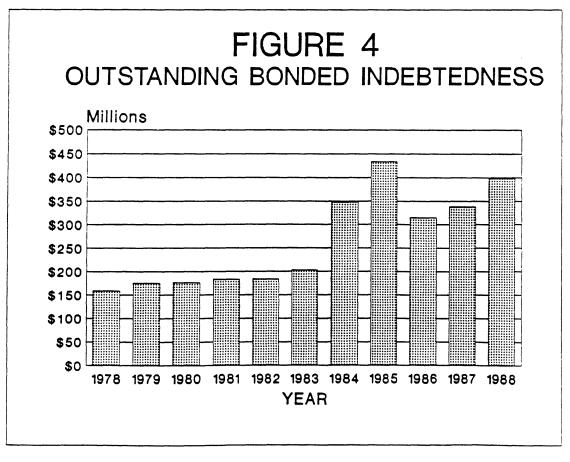
# FIGURE 1 Governmental Revenues \$2,340,726,825

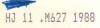
