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The Office of the State Auditor is a Constitutional office which provides a post-audit function for local governmental units. The Office attests to the fairness of these financial statements as well as to their compliance with applicable laws and regulations.

In general, the Office facilitates improved financial management practices within the State through its oversight programs and contributes to the ongoing economic education of public officials and taxpayers.

The State Auditor has financial oversight for over 4,400 local units of government. The local units of government include the following:

- 543 educational districts
- 87 counties
- 716 police and fire relief association funds
- 159 housing and redevelopment authorities
- 22 port authorities
- 91 soil and water conservation districts
- 150 (approximate) special districts

The State Auditor also maintains a database of financial information on local governments. The data are collected by the Financial Health Program which assesses long-term trends for cities and counties.

The State Auditor serves on the State's Executive Council, Land Exchange Board, State Investment Board, State Housing Finance Agency, Rural Finance Administration Board, and the Public Employees Retirement Association Board.

The annual report of the State Auditor covers the revenues, expenditures, indebtedness, taxable tax capacities and tax levies of the counties in Minnesota for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1989. Populations are the 1990 census counts from the U.S. Census Bureau. This information has been collected and is published and distributed pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Sections 6.74 and 6.75.

The Office of the State Auditor has generated this report using d.BASE IV and IBM PS/2's. Anyone who wishes to analyze the data further, including receiving a copy on diskettes, should contact this office for assistance.

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GENERAL SUMMARY

SCOPE

This report presents financial data on the 87 counties in Minnesota for the fiscal year ended December 31, 1989. The data in this report were generated from the audited annual financial statements of the counties and from Department of Revenue reports of levies and tax capacities. All counties report their governmental funds on the modified accrual basis of accounting.

OPERATIONS

A comparative summary of revenues, expenditures, and outstanding bonded indebtedness of the counties for the years 1985 through 1989 is presented in Table 1. Governmental revenues and expenditures reported in Tables 2 and 3 include the general fund and all other governmental funds. County hospitals and nursing homes are considered public service enterprises and their financial operations are presented in separate tables. Population figures are based on the 1990 census counts from the U.S. Census Bureau.

Counties serve as agents for other governmental units in the collection and distribution of taxes and grants, in addition to their governmental functions. The county "agency" funds that account for these monies are not included in the report.

REVENUES

Revenues of county governmental funds totaled \$2.59 billion in 1989, which is \$249 million or 10.6% higher than in 1988. The two main sources of county revenues are property taxes and intergovernmental revenues, which together accounted for 83.8% of total revenues in 1989.

Over the past five years the percentage of revenues from taxes has increased from 32.0% in 1985 to 34.7% in 1990. Intergovernmental revenues have declined from 52.1% in 1985 to 49.1% in 1989. During this five year-period the amount of taxes collected increased from \$634.3 million to \$897.5 million, and intergovernmental revenues increased from \$1.03 billion to \$1.27 billion.

EXPENDITURES

Expenditures (excluding principal payment on debt) by counties for governmental functions in 1989 totaled \$2.59 billion, which is an increase of \$256.8 million, or 11.0% over 1988. The increase in five years is \$628.9 million, or 32%. Most of the increase over the five years from 1985 to 1989 came from Human Services, which rose \$288.6 million. Public safety expenditures rose \$86.5 million, highway expenditures increased \$68.9 million, and general government rose \$128.6 million during the last five years.

Human Services is the largest county function, accounting for 52.8% of the total current expenditures in 1989.

This report does not include direct welfare payments for the counties made by the State Department of Human Services. Six counties do not report detailed welfare expenditures. These six comprise two welfare districts and report all expenditures in the "Other Welfare Costs" category. Consequently, the detail of welfare expenditures is presented for reference purposes only. Lincoln, Lyon and Murray counties comprise the Region VIII North Welfare Board and the counties of Faribault, Martin, and Watonwan form the Faribault–Martin–Watonwan Human Services Board.

OPERATIONS OF PUBLIC SERVICE ENTERPRISES

The financial operations of county hospitals, nursing homes, and other county service enterprises are presented in Tables 5, 6 and 7. These enterprise funds report their operations using the accrual basis of accounting.

The 15 county hospitals had operating revenues of \$222.3 million and operating expenses of \$229.3 million, resulting in an operating loss of \$7.1 million. The non-operating revenues (primarily Hennepin county's \$18.4 million in taxes and grants) resulted in net income of \$9.5 million for all hospitals.

Counties operated 17 nursing homes during 1989. The results of operation for 15 of the nursing homes are shown on Table 6. (Two nursing homes include their operation with the county hospital). County nursing homes had operating revenues of \$42.6 million and operating expenses of \$44.8 million. Net operating loss was \$2.2 million; however, non-operating revenues reduced the net loss to \$1.4 million compared to a net loss of \$1.7 million for the prior year.

Thirty-three counties operate 50 other public service enterprise funds, which include nursing services, and sanitation operations. In this category, operating revenues totaled \$78.2 million, and operating expenses totaled \$75.4 million, resulting in an operating income of \$2.8 million. Non-operating revenues increased net income to a profitable \$9.4 million.

INDEBTEDNESS

Outstanding bonded debt of the counties, as shown in Table 4, was \$644.6 million at the end of 1989, an increase of \$246.1 million from 1988. Twenty-four counties issued bonds during 1989 totaling \$374 million as compared to 26 counties issuing \$87.2 million in 1988.

During 1989, the counties issued bonds totaling \$374 million and retired bonds totaling \$127.9 million, leaving \$644.6 million outstanding at December 31, 1989. In Table 4, the liabilities for compensated absences totaled \$103.6 million, and other long-term debt totaled \$102.8 million.

FIGURE 1 Governmental Revenues \$2,589,690,866

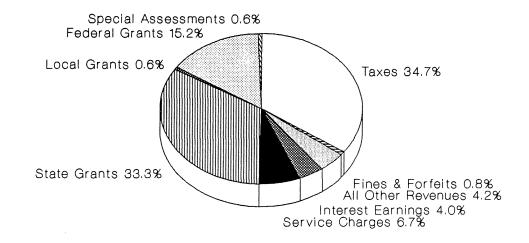
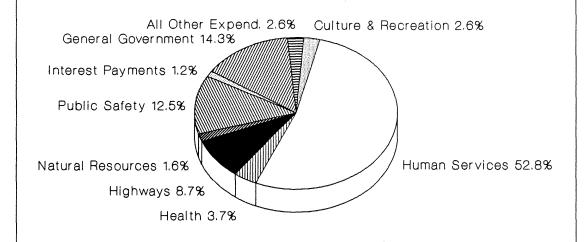
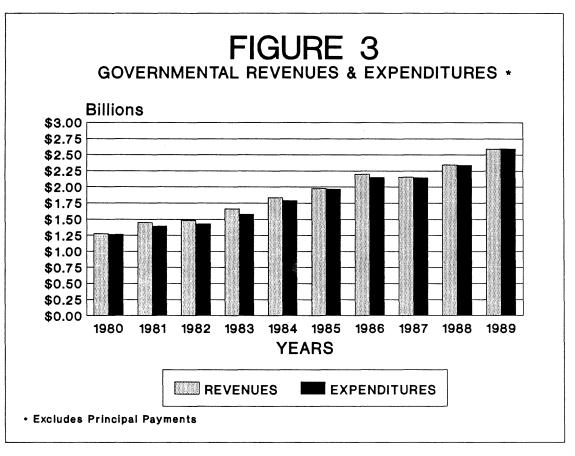
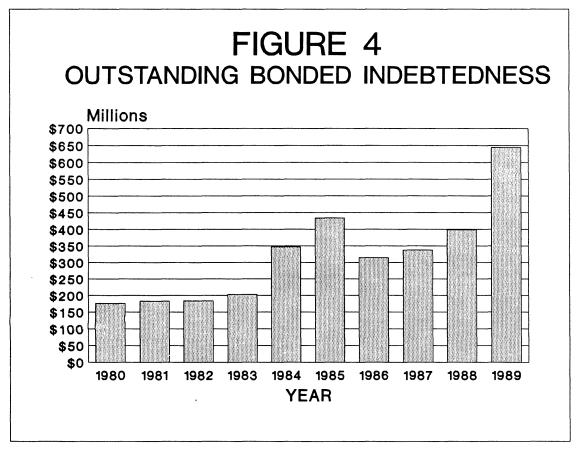


FIGURE 2 Governmental Current Expenditures \$2,252,859,580
