### Clause a: GENERAL STATEMENT OF BOARD ACTIVITIES

Covering both FY 1989 and FY 1990

During the FY 89-90 biennium the Board of Psychology adopted amendments to the rules adopted in 1982, which tightened education and employment requirements for licensure, clarified and added to the rules of conduct, changed the method of processing fees for taking the national examination, and instituted a field of practice oral examination and a written jurisprudence examination to replace the existing oral examination based on the Board's law and rules.

Implementation of the amended rules increased the time commitment for Board members due to developing the replacement examinations and requiring closer examination of applications for licensure to be sure they met rule requirements for licensure.

The number of complaints continues to be high relative to the number of licensees, averaging well over 100 complaints per year, most of which are jurisdictional, that is, against licensees and/or applicants for licensure.

During FY 1989 the application process began to be computerized, with the October, 1988, administration of the national examination being the first one assisted by computer data. The professional corporation list was also computerized in FY 1989. By FY 1990 it became clear that computerizing licensure data would require the addition of another staff person. The incumbent in the Clerk Typist 3 position was made a half-time Clerk Typist 4 (with an inter-agency agreement with another board), working with complaints and summary data, and the vacant Clerk Typist 3 position was filled with a person competent in data entry, retrieval, and manipulation. The process of putting licensure data into the computer, with the capability of retrieving the names by renewal date, licensure number, ZIP code, city, or county, was started in the last quarter of FY 1990. To facilitate the work of the shared staff person, a doorway was cut through the wall separating the two boards, and effectively enlarging the Board's crowded office space.

Several Board members took part in national forums whose purpose was to improve regulatory board members' performance in their role of protecting the public from unethical and unprofessional conduct.

During FY 1990 a bill was introduced in the legislature (promoted by a professional association) which would have eliminated independent, unsupervised practice for future master's level applicants. After two days of hearings on the matter conducted by the Board, the Board took the position, by a 6 to 3 vote (with two members absent), not to support the bill, and to convey this position, along with the reasons for it, to the legislature. The bill was "laid over for study in the interim" by the Senate Health and Human Services Committee, effectively killing the bill for the session. The Board's position

was based on the following: insufficient evidence that master's level licensees were not as a group performing competently; negative effect on con- sumers due to fewer licensees and higher costs; closing the door on licensure opportunities for women and minorities; evidence from the Board's disciplinary data that far more doctoral level licensees had been disciplined than master's level licensees, despite the fact that the numbers of both kinds of licensees are almost equal.
