2. NURSING EDUCATION ACTIVITIES

In accordance with Minnesota Statutes section 148.251, the Board approved nursing education programs that prepare persons for licensure as either registered professional nurses or licensed practical nurses.

Approval of one new practical nursing program at Southwestern Technical College in Pipestone was granted in FY 1991. The controlling institutions operating the Austin, Faribault and Rochester Technical Colleges' practical nursing programs were consolidated into Minnesota Riverland Technical College with campuses in each city. Austin and Faribault Technical Colleges voluntarily closed their programs to begin alignment with Rochester. Therefore, approval was terminated for the two closed programs; approval continues for the renamed Minnesota Riverland Technical College Practical Mursing Program, with campuses in Rochester, Austin and Faribault.

Clause p: (continued)

The College of St. Catherine Department of Nursing which prepares professional nurses separated from the Minnesota Intercollegiate Nursing Consortium (MINC) and returned to independent operation. St. Olaf College and Gustavus Adolphus College continue in the consortium.

The loss of professional staff due to early retirement resulted in few surveys for renewal of approval for the purpose of determining continued compliance with administrative rules. Three partial surveys of practical nursing schools were completed in FY 1991 due to low passing rates of graduates on the licensing examination. One partial survey of a practical nurse program was completed in FY 1992 in response to expressed student concerns. Each of the above practical nursing programs was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules. Two professional nurse programs were surveyed and approved during FY 1992.

4. NURSING ASSISTANT REGISTRY

From July 1, 1990 to December 31, 1991, the Board continued to implement portions of Public Law 100-203 (called OBRA '87) pertaining to nursing assistant training, competency evaluation programs and a registry of nursing assistants who work in long term care facilities.

Authorization for these activities was provided under a contract with the Minnesota Department of Health and Minnesota Statutes Section 144A.61 that expired on December 31, 1991. On January 1, 1992, all activities for the administering the nursing assistant registry were transferred to the Minnesota Department of Health.

During FY 91 and 92 (up to December 31, 1991), the Board approved 51 training programs and one curriculum. When the program was transferred to the health department, a total of 95 training programs had been approved by the Board since the initiation of the registry in FY 89. Also since that time, the Board had approved three curricula to be used in these training programs.

As of June 30, 1991, 36,366 nursing assistants were on the registry. For that portion of FY 92 that the registry was administered by this agency, 38,901 nursing assistants were on the registry.

- c. Board activities: Investigation; Board Review Panel.
- d. Disposition: Consent Order of Indefinite Suspension.
- e. Reason for Disposition: Nature of the allegation, seriousness of nurse's behavior, the nurse's lack of knowledge of and history of inability to recognize and maintain professional and personal boundaries.

 - e. Reason for Disposition: Nature and seriousness of the allegations; necessity for therapy and professional consultation on the maintenance of personal and professional boundaries.

- e. Reason for Disposition: Sufficient evidence of rehabilitation including sex offender treatment program, supervised probation through 1998, and successfully completed nursing education program since treatment.
- 9. a. Allegation: A female registered nurse accepted the invitation of a former female psychiatric patient to have a personal relationship which included sexual contact, after the patient had been discharged from a treatment facility which also employed the nurse.
 - b. Investigation: Non-jurisdictional. The nurse was not assigned to care for the patient and did not enter into a therapeutic relationship with the patient while the patient was admitted to the facility. Therefore, the nurse's personal relationship with the patient did not constitute unprofessional conduct.
 - c. Board activities: Review of written response from nurse and other written materials.
 - d. Disposition: case dismissed.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Non-jurisdictional matter.
- 10. a. Allegation: A female candidate for practical nurse licensure by examination had a personal relationship including sexual contact with a male quadraplegic resident from an extended care facility.
 - b. Investigation: Initially referred to Minnesota Department of Health because alleged perpetrator was a nursing assistant at the time of the alleged relationship. Awaiting results of referral. Candidate failed the licensed practical nurse licensure examination and has not reapplied.

- e. Reason for Disposition: Seriousness of the allegation and the nurse's lack of knowledge of professional boundaries. Nurse agreed to therapy regarding setting professional boundaries.
- 12. a. Allegation: A female licensed practical nurse had personal relationships including sexual contact with two male patients while enrolled in a Monitored Antabuse Community Program and after discharge.
 - b. Investigation substantiated the allegations.
 - c. Board activities: Board Review Panel
 - d. Disposition: Consent Order of Indefinite Suspension
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Nature and seriousness of allegations, nurse's refusal to terminate relationships after warnings from her supervisor, nurse's lack of knowledge of and history of inability to maintain professional and personal boundaries.
- 13. a. Allegation: A female registered nurse made comments with sexual innuendos, made sexual advances, and used inappropriate behavioral boundaries towards patients and other staff in a psychiatric hospital.
 - b. Investigation: Investigation supported the allegations. Nurse denied the allegations and believed they were taken out of context and misinterpreted.
 - c. Board activities: Board Review Panel.
 - d. Disposition: Consent Order of Limited and Conditional License.

- 14. a. Allegation: A male licensed practical nurse touched an elderly female resident inappropriately when performing perineal care while the resident was admitted to a long-term care facility.
 - b. Investigation: Evidence was inconclusive. Nurse denied allegation and patient had a history of forgetfulness and taking narcotics for medical condition.
 - c. Board activities: Review of submitted materials, including OHFC investigative report.
 - d. Disposition: Case dismissed.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Insufficient evidence to support allegations.

- 15. a. Allegation: A female licensed practical nurse initiated a personal relationship with a female psychiatric patient who was admitted to a mental health facility for a history of chemical dependency and family abuse. The relationship included sexual contact and the mutual use of drugs and alcohol, and occurred while the patient was admitted to the facility and after discharge.
 - b. Investigation substantiated the allegations. Nurse believed her own chemical dependency problem contributed to the alleged incident.
 - c. Board activities: Board Review Panel.
 - d. Disposition: Consent Order of Indefinite Suspension.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Nature and seriousness of allegations and patient's medical history. Nurse's lack of knowledge of and inability to maintain professional and personal boundaries. Nurse's refusal to terminate relationship after warning from her supervisor.
- 16. a. Allegation: A male licensed practical nurse was convicted of first and second degree criminal sexual conduct involving a female minor. This conduct did not involve a patient.
 - b. Investigation: Pending
 - c. Board activities: Pending
 - d. Disposition: Pending
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Pending
- 17. a. Allegation: A female registered nurse inappropriately gave perineal care to an elderly female patient during a sponge bath. The patient had been hospitalized for a knee injury.
 - b. Investigation was inconclusive. Nurse denied allegations.
 - c. Board activities: Board Review Panel with review of additional documents.
 - d. Disposition: Written warning to the nurse.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Although insufficient evidence to support inappropriate behavior, nurse advised to use effective communication skills in explaining procedures to patients.

- 18. a. Allegation: A male licensed practical nurse, who was also an applicant for licensure by examination as a registered nurse, had sexual contact with a female patient who had a history of mental illness and chemical dependency and had been hospitalized for detoxification. The nurse was charged with third degree criminal sexual conduct.
 - b. Investigation was inconclusive. The charge of criminal sexual conduct was dismissed. Nurse denied allegations.
 - c. Board activities: Board Review Panel.
 - d. Disposition: Written warning to nurse and registered nurse licensure granted.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Although insufficient evidence to support the allegations, nurse advised to maintain professional boundaries.
- 19. a. Allegation: A male registered nurse was charged with criminal sexual misconduct in another jurisdiction for sexual contact of two minor males while working in a pre-adolescent treatment center located in another state.
 - b. Investigation: Acquitted of criminal charges. Other state board of nursing investigated and closed case.
 - c. Board activities: Review of documents from other jurisdiction.
 - d. Disposition: Case dismissed.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: No action taken in jurisdiction where allegations occurred. Insufficient evidence to substantiate the allegation.
- 20. a. Allegation: A male licensed practical nurse engaged in sexual contact including sexual intercourse with a female patient who was admitted to a psychiatric hospital.
 - b. Investigation substantiated the allegations. Nurse denied allegations.
 - c. Board activities: Board Review Panel.
 - d. Disposition: Consent Order of Limited and Conditional License.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Nature and seriousness of allegations. Nurse denied any sexual contact with patient. Until nurse completes training on professional boundaries, need to restrict assignment to non-psychiatric patients.

- 23. a. Allegation: A male nurse registered nurse anesthetist inappropriately touched the breasts of several female patients while they were anesthetized and under his care.

- 24. a. Allegation: A male registered nurse touched a female patient inappropriately after she was sedated and when preparing the patient for surgery.
