During each fiscal year, 1993 and 1994, each program indicated compliance with all applicable rules.

Programs are surveyed for continued compliance with applicable Minnesota Rules at least once every ten years. During FY93, two professional nursing programs were surveyed. Each was granted renewal of approval. Three practical nursing programs were also surveyed. Two received renewal of approval and one received renewal of approval with the recommendation for a partial survey during FY94 to monitor compliance with specified rules.

During FY94, one professional nursing program was surveyed and received renewal of approval. Three practical nursing programs were surveyed; each was granted renewal of approval. The partial survey of the practical nursing program was conducted; the program was found to be in compliance with the specified rules.

 - d. Disposition: Written warning to the nurse. Advised that the nurse has the responsibility to maintain appropriate boundaries in a nurse/patient relationship. If another report of similar nature is received, the matter will be re-evaluated.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Nurse denied sexual conduct and there were no subsequent complaints.
- 2. Pending from Previous Fiscal Year
 - a. Allegations: A female registered nurse began a personal relationship with a female patient hospitalized for chemical dependency treatment which continued after the patient's discharge and included sexual contact.
 - b. Investigation substantiated the allegation.
 - c. Board activities: Investigation; Board Review Panel.
 - d. Disposition: Stipulation and Consent Order for a Limited and Conditional License.
 - Reason for Disposition: Nature and seriousness of allegations, limited understanding of appropriate professional boundaries and necessity of therapy and monitoring.

- 3. Pending from previous Fiscal Year
 - a. Allegations: A female candidate for licensed practical nurse licensure by examination had a social relationship including sexual contact with a male quadraplegic resident from an extended care facility.
 - b. Investigation: Referred to Minnesota Department of Health because alleged perpetrator was a nursing assistant at the time of the alleged relationship.
 - c. Board activities: Review of investigation. Referral to MDH.
 - d. Disposition: Case closed.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Candidate failed the licensed practical nurse licensure examination and has not reapplied.
- 4. Pending from Previous Fiscal Year
 - a. Allegations: A male licensed practical nurse was convicted of first and second degree criminal sexual conduct involving a minor female. This conduct did not involve a patient.
 - Investigation: Convicted of criminal charges. Conviction upheld on appeal.
 - c. Board activities: Contested case hearing initiated. Nurse withdrew from hearing.
 - d. Disposition: Pending.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Pending.
- 5. Pending from Previous Fiscal Year
 - A. Allegations: A female registered nurse engaged in sexual contact including sexual intercourse with a male patient admitted to a correctional facility infirmary.
 - b. Investigation substantiated the allegation.
 - c. Board activities: Board Review Panel; Review of additional written material.
 - d. Disposition: Stipulation and Consent Order of Indefinite Suspension.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Nature and seriousness of the allegation, need for professional mental health evaluation and treatment regarding understanding of appropriate professional roles, identity and boundaries.

- 6. Pending from Previous Fiscal Year
 - a. Allegations: A male certified registered nurse anesthetist inappropriately touched the breasts of several female patients while they were anesthetized and under his care.
 - b. Investigation substantiated the allegations.
 - c. Board activities: Board Review Panel.
 - d. Disposition: Stipulation and Consent Order for Conditional License.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Nature and seriousness of the allegations. The nurse self-reported his conduct and initiated a psychological evaluation and treatment. Ongoing need for therapy and monitoring.
- 7. Pending from Previous Fiscal Year
 - a. Allegations: A male registered nurse touched a female patient inappropriately after she was sedated while the nurse prepared the patient for surgery.
 - b. Investigation was inconclusive but supported the allegations.
 - c. Board activities: Investigation; Board Review Panel; Review of additional written materials.
 - d. Disposition: Stipulation and Consent Order for a Limited and Conditional License.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Nature and seriousness of allegations, need for professional evaluation and therapy regarding boundaries and inappropriate conduct and ongoing monitoring of conduct while in practice.
- 8. Pending from Previous Fiscal Year
 - a. Allegations: A male licensed practical nurse established a personal relationship with a female psychiatric patient hospitalized for bipolar disorder and indiscriminate sexual behaviors. The relationship included sexual contact after the patient was discharged.

The nurse was also charged with second degree criminal sexual conduct involving a minor female, who was not a patient.

- b. Investigation: Both allegations were substantiated. The nurse was convicted of second degree criminal sexual conduct.
- c. Board activities: Contested case hearing resulting in default.
- d. Disposition: Order of Indefinite Suspension.

- e. Reason for Disposition: Nature and seriousness of the multiple allegations.
- 9. Pending from Previous Fiscal Year
 - a. Allegations: A male registered nurse made sexual remarks and advances (including kissing the patient) towards a male hospitalized patient while the patient was sedated.
 - b. Investigation: The nurse admitted the contact but denied sexual intent. The nurse denied making sexual remarks.
 - c. Board activities: Board Review Panel.
 - d. Disposition: Stipulation and Consent Order for Conditional License.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Nature and seriousness of allegations, necessity of professional consultation on the maintenance of personal and professional boundaries with emphasis on respecting and understanding cultural differences.
- 10. Pending from Previous Fiscal Year
 - a. Allegations: A male registered nurse initiated a non-therapeutic relationship with a female hospitalized psychiatric patient which continued after the patient was discharged but still involved in psychotherapy. The relationship involved sexual contact.
 - b. Investigation inconclusive. Nurse admitted friendship with patient but denied sexual involvement. Other evidence indicated the relationship included sexual involvement.
 - c. Board activities: Board Review Panel,
 - d. Disposition: Stipulation and Consent Order for a Conditional License.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Nature and seriousness of allegations, lack of knowledge and inability to recognize and maintain professional and personal boundaries, necessity of therapy and education.
- 11. a. Allegations: A male applicant for licensure as a registered nurse was convicted of criminal sexual conduct involving a female who was not a patient and engaged in sexual contact with a female patient who was intoxicated.
 - b. Investigation substantiated the allegations.
 - c. Board activities: Investigation; Board Review Panel; review of additional written materials including a recent mental health evaluation and positive employment performance evaluation.
 - d. Disposition: Granted a conditional license.

- e. Reason for Disposition: Nature and seriousness of behavior, no complaints in past 10 years, subsequent remedial measures by the nurse, need to strengthen measures taken with additional education and periodic reports.
- 12. a. Allegations: A male registered nurse working as a residential counselor had sexual contact with a juvenile male resident on multiple occasions. The nurse was not licensed as a registered nurse at the time of the incident.
 - b. Investigation substantiated the allegations. The nurse pled guilty to three counts of criminal sexual conduct.
 - c. Board activities: Board Review Panel.
 - d. Disposition: Stipulation and Consent Order for a Limited and Conditional License.
 - Reason for Disposition: Nature and seriousness of the allegations, need for therapy for nurse to understand professional role and boundaries.
- 13. a. Allegations: A male registered nurse had sexual contact with a hospitalized male patient. Nurse was charged with criminal sexual conduct.
 - b. Investigation substantiated the allegations. The nurse entered an agreement on criminal charges.
 - c. Board activities: Review of written materials including a Pretrial Release Agreement and Order and reports from the nurse's psychologist.
 - d. Disposition: Stipulation and Consent Order for Suspension.
 - Reason for Disposition: Nature and seriousness of the allegations, need for psychotherapy to understand professional role and boundaries.
- 14. a. Allegations: A female registered nurse began a personal relationship with a male patient hospitalized for chemical dependency and psychiatric disorders. The relationship involved sexual contact.
 - b. Investigation substantiated the allegations. The nurse admitted having a personal and sexual relationship with the patient but stated the relationship began prior to the patient's hospitalization.
 - c. Board activities: Board Review Panel.
 - d. Disposition: Stipulation and Consent Order for a Conditional License.

- Reason for Disposition: Nature and seriousness of the allegations, need for therapy/education to understand role and professional boundaries.
- 15. a. Allegations: A registered nurse kissed, hugged, inappropriately touched and made remarks of a sexual nature to a female patient hospitalized for mental health treatment.
 - b. Investigation did not support the allegations.
 - c. Board activities: Investigation.
 - d. Disposition: Dismissed with a warning letter to the nurse.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Credibility of complainant questionable. Insufficient evidence.
- 16. a. Allegations: A female registered nurse had a personal and sexual relationship with a male detoxification patient.
 - b. Investigation substantiated the personal relationship did not support the sexual relationship.
 - c. Board activities: Board Review Panel.
 - d. Disposition: Stipulation and Consent Order for a Conditional License.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Nature of the allegations, need for education about appropriate nurse-patient boundaries.
- 17. a. Allegations: A female registered nurse kissed and sexually touched a male nursing home resident.
 - b. Investigation did not support the allegations.
 - c. Board activities: Review of written materials.
 - d. Disposition: Case dismissed.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Insufficient evidence supporting allegations.
- 18. a. Allegations: A female registered nurse touched the genitals of a minor female during a physical examination at a physician's office.
 - b. Investigation did not support the allegations.
 - c. Board activities: Investigation and review of written material.
 - d. Disposition: Dismissed as false.

- e. Reason for Disposition: Allegations unfounded.
- 19. a. Allegations: A female registered nurse sexually touched a hospitalized female patient and touched herself in the presence of the patient.
 - b. Investigation indicated nurse may have touched patient's breasts while assisting the patient in showering but touch of patient and self was unintentional and not sexually motivated.
 - c. Board activities: Board Review Panel.
 - d. Disposition: Dismissed with a warning.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Nurse advised to be cognizant of implications of touch, regardless of intention. Nurse completed a course and wrote a paper regarding boundaries and implications of touch. Nurse also had subsequent satisfactory work report and a satisfactory psychological evaluation.

- 21. a. Allegations: A male licensed practical nurse inappropriately touched a male nursing home resident while assisting the resident with dressing. The nurse also made remarks of a sexual nature to the resident. The nurse exposed himself to another male nursing home resident and made remarks of a sexual nature. The nurse asked a third male nursing home resident to touch him sexually. The nurse sodomized another male nursing home resident.
 - b. Investigation pending. Criminal charges pending.
 - c. Board activities: Pending.
 - d. Disposition: Stipulation to Cease Practicing Nursing.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Nature and seriousness of allegations. Further action may be taken pending outcome of investigation.

 - d. Disposition: Pending.
 - e. Reason for Disposition: Pending.

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
