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Overview

In 1994, Minnesota's 87 counties spent a total of \$3.10 billion to provide a broad range of public

The current expenditures of counties totaled \$2.54 billion in 1994, an increase of 2.4 percent over 1993. services.¹ Of the \$3.10 billion in county spending, current expenditures accounted for \$2.54 billion; capital outlays accounted for \$426.7 million; and debt service accounted for \$136.0 million. Current expenditures increased 2.4 percent between 1993 and 1994.

To support these services, Minnesota counties collected total revenues of \$3.07 billion in 1994, which was an increase of \$112.0 million over total revenues collected in 1993. Counties generated higher revenues from taxes, intergovernmental grants and aids, charges for services, licenses and permits, special assessments, and interest earnings.

Governmental Revenues

Counties raised \$3.07 billion to finance public services in 1994, \$112.0 million more than in 1993. The principal sources of revenues for Minnesota counties were: intergovernmental revenues (44.4 percent), taxes (37.6 percent), and charges for services (8.2 percent).

Intergovernmental revenues, taxes and charges for services accounted for over 90 percent of county revenues in 1994.

• Intergovernmental revenues. Intergovernmental revenues were the largest source of revenues for counties in 1994, accounting for 44.4 percent of all county revenues. Intergovernmental revenues, which include grants and aids from federal, state and local governments, totaled \$1.36 billion in 1994, an increase of 2.9 percent over 1993.

While intergovernmental revenues continued to provide the largest share of county revenues, the percentage of total revenues derived from intergovernmental revenues has declined from 49.8 percent in 1990 to 44.4 percent in 1994. The decrease was the result of several factors. The most significant factor in the decline of intergovernmental revenues was a change in state policy that shifted a portion of the financial responsibility for courts and several human service programs from the counties to the state. As the state has assumed greater financial responsibility for these programs, the aid provided to counties has decreased. The shift in costs from the counties to the state has also affected the amount of federal aid to counties. The federal aid that pays for a portion of the costs of certain human service programs now remains at the state level rather than flowing to the counties.

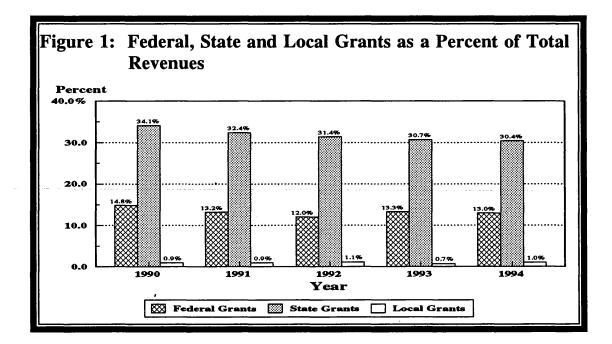
State grants and aids. The largest provider of intergovernmental revenues to counties in 1994 was the state of Minnesota. State grants and aids to counties totaled \$934.2 million in 1994, an increase of \$24.5 million over 1993. While revenues from state grants increased in 1994, the proportion of county revenues derived from state grants decreased slightly from 30.7 percent in 1993 to 30.4 percent in 1994.

The principal state aids and grants for counties and their percent of total revenues are human services aid (9.3 percent), highway aid (8.9 percent), and homestead credit and agricultural aid (HACA) (6.3 percent). Between 1993 and 1994, HACA increased 10.1 percent; highway aid increased 4.3 percent; and, human service aid decreased 8.3 percent.

Federal grants and aids. The federal government provided revenues of \$399.4 million to Minnesota counties in 1994, up \$6.8 million or 1.7 percent from 1993. The share of revenues derived from federal grants decreased from 13.3 percent in 1993 to 13.0 percent in 1994.

The majority of federal aid to counties is in the form of human service grants. Human service grants and aids to counties totaled \$307.9 million in 1994, a decrease of 0.7 percent from 1993. During the period of 1990 to 1994, federal human service aid decreased 16.8 percent.

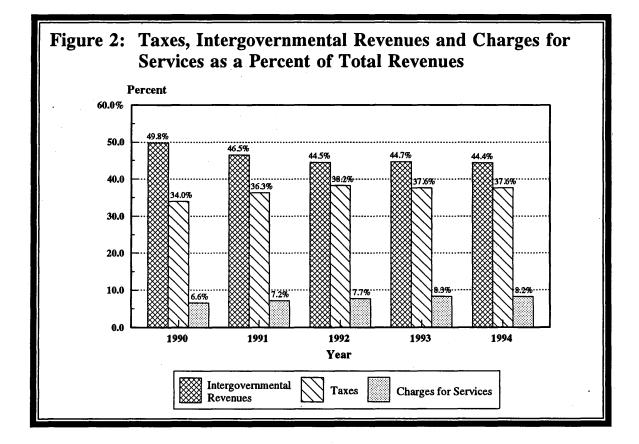
Local unit grants. Grants from local governments to counties totaled \$29.8 million in 1994, up 35.1 percent from 1993. Hennepin County was largely responsible for the increase in local grants as it reported a \$6.6 million or 236 percent increase in 1994. Hennepin County indicated that the increase was due to participation by local governments in road projects. Figure 1 illustrates federal, state and local grants as a percent of total revenues for the years 1990 through 1994.

- **Taxes.**² Taxes represented the second largest source of revenues for counties at 37.6 percent of all county revenues. Counties collected tax revenues of \$1.15 billion in 1994, an increase of \$42.3 million or 3.8 percent over 1993. Over the five-year period of 1990 through 1994, the share of county revenues derived from taxes increased from 34.0 percent to 37.6 percent. Revenues from taxes grew 21.3 percent between 1990 and 1994.
- **Charges for services.** Counties received revenues from charges for services totaling \$252.5 million in 1994, an increase of \$7.5 million or 3.1 percent over 1993. Charges for services have become an increasingly important source of revenues for counties. Over the five-year period of 1990 to 1994, revenues from charges for services increased 37.2 percent, which caused its share of total revenues to grow from 6.6 percent in 1990 to 8.2 percent in 1994.

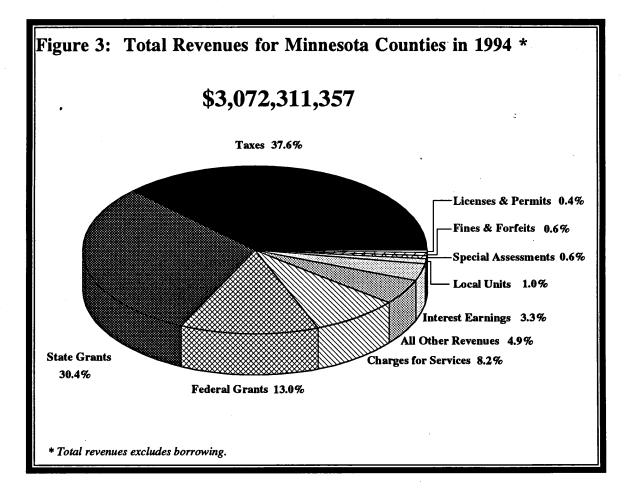
Figure 2 provides a comparison of intergovernmental revenues, taxes, and charges for services for the years 1990 through 1994.

- *Fines and forfeits.* The category "fines and forfeits", which decreased \$24,641 or 0.1 percent, was the only source of revenues that declined between 1993 and 1994.
- Other sources of revenues. Other sources of county revenues that rose between 1993 and 1994 were interest earnings which increased \$1.8 million or 1.8 percent; licenses and permits which increased \$1.8 million or 16.7 percent; special assessments which increased \$1.5 million or 9.1 percent; and the "all other revenues" category which increased \$18.1 million or 13.6 percent.

Figure 3 illustrates the proportion of revenue that each source provides.



Borrowing

The amount of bonds and other long-term debt issued by counties totaled \$78.1 million in 1994, a decrease of \$110.5 million or 58.6 percent from 1993.³ Counties issued bonds totaling \$57.9 million and other long-term debt of \$20.2 million in 1994.

Total Governmental Expenditures

Current Expenditures

Minnesota's 87 counties had total current expenditures of \$2.54 billion in 1994, an increase of \$60.0 million or 2.4 percent over 1993.

• Human service programs. Counties spent \$1.15 billion on human service programs in 1994, more than twice as much as any other current expenditure. Although human

services continued to account for the largest share of current expenditures, spending on county human service programs decreased \$21.1 million, or 1.8 percent between 1993 and 1994. Ramsey County, which reported a \$13.4 million decrease in human service expenditures, accounted for over half of the statewide decrease. In 1994, the state began

paying vendors of certain "waivered" medical assistance programs directly rather than reimbursing the county for the costs. The cost shift decreased human service expenditures in the majority of counties but was more pronounced in Ramsey and Hennepin Counties. However, in Hennepin County, the overall expenditures on human services increased because the county initiated new human service programs in 1994 that added expenses that were greater than the savings recognized from the cost shift.

The category of human services spending is made up of social services, income maintenance, and "other" human service expenditures. Between 1993 and 1994, spending on income maintenance programs grew by 0.3 percent while spending on social services and "other" human services decreased by 1.9 percent and 4.5 percent respectively.

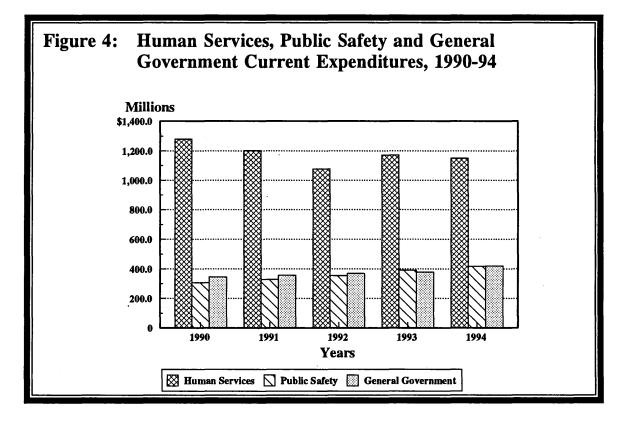
Over the five-year period of 1990 to 1994, human service expenditures decreased 10.1 percent. The decrease in human service expenditures was caused by cost shifts from the counties to the state. From 1990 to 1994, spending on income maintenance programs and "other" human service programs decreased 38.4 percent and 14.4 percent respectively, while spending on social service programs increased 37.0 percent.

• General government services. Counties spent \$418.2 million on general government services in 1994, accounting for 16.5 percent of all current expenditures. Spending on general government services rose \$39.9 million or 10.5 percent between 1993 and 1994. This represented the largest dollar increase of any category of current expenditures. Over one-third of the increase was attributable to Hennepin County, which shifted staff from social services to general government.

Spending on public safety, which includes expenditures for sheriff, Public safety. corrections, ambulance, and other safety-related services, totaled \$417.4 million in 1994. This was an increase of \$26.8 million or 6.9 percent over 1993. Public safety services accounted for 16.4 percent of all current expenditures in 1994, up from 15.8 percent in 1993.

Spending on public safety increased 6.9 percent in 1994.

Figure 4 compares current expenditures for human services, public safety and general government services for the years 1990 through 1994.



Sanitation. Sanitation current expenditures totaled \$49.8 million in 1994, an increase of \$8.1 million or 19.6 percent over 1993. Sanitation expenditures were affected by accounting changes in Anoka and Dakota Counties, as well as new regulations related to landfills in other counties.

Streets and highways. Current expenditures for street and highway administration and maintenance totaled \$215.0 million in 1994.

Street and highway current expenditures declined \$4.5 million or 2.1 percent between 1993 and 1994. Street and highway current expenditures do not include expenditures for street and highway construction which accounted for another \$302.8 million in spending for counties in 1994.

Current expenditures for street and highway administration and maintenance totaled \$215.0 million in 1994; street construction added another \$302.8 million in county spending.

• Other current expenditures. Minnesota counties also increased spending on conservation of natural resources by \$5.0 million or 11.5 percent, economic development by \$3.6 million or 12.9 percent, culture and recreation by \$1.5 million or 2.0 percent, and health by \$133,819 or 0.1 percent.

Capital Outlay and Debt Service

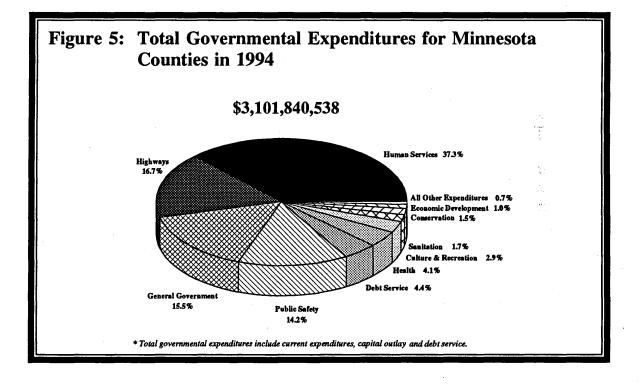
In addition to current expenditures of \$2.54 billion, counties spent \$426.7 million on capital projects and \$136.0 million on debt service in 1994.⁴ Capital spending was up \$16.6 million or 4.1 percent and debt service expenditures were up \$4.3 million or 3.3 percent from 1993.

Counties spent \$302.8 million on street and highway capital projects in 1994, accounting for 71.0 percent of all county capital outlays. Counties increased capital outlay for general government projects by \$11.6 million or 22.8 percent, projects related

to health by \$6.2 million or 134.2 percent, projects related service projects by \$3.8 million or 165.7 percent. Counties reduced capital outlays for economic development by\$9.9 million or 99.9 percent, public safety by \$2.4 million or 9.2 percent, sanitation by \$1.1 million or 19.9 percent, and culture and recreation by\$2.9 million or 18.2 percent.

Street and highway capital projects accounted for 71 percent of all capital outlays for counties.

Figure 5 provides a summary of total governmental expenditures that includes current expenditures, capital outlay and debt service.

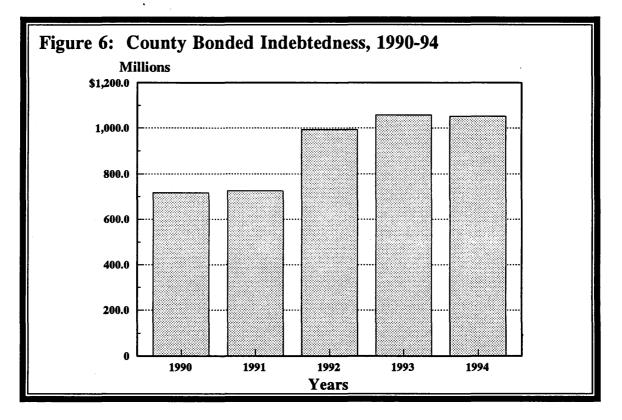

Indebtedness

Counties reported bonded debt of \$1.05 billion on December 31, 1994. This was a decrease of \$6.4 million or 0.6 percent from 1993. Twenty-seven counties issued bonds totaling \$85.2 million in 1994, compared to 40 counties that issued bonds totaling \$166.4 million in 1993. Counties retired bonds totaling \$92.5 million in 1994 compared to \$100.8 million in 1993. Counties also reported liabilities for compensated absences of \$175.8 million and other long-term debt of \$264.0 million in 1994. Figure 6 illustrates the growth in county bonded indebtedness, 1990-94.



Public Service Enterprises

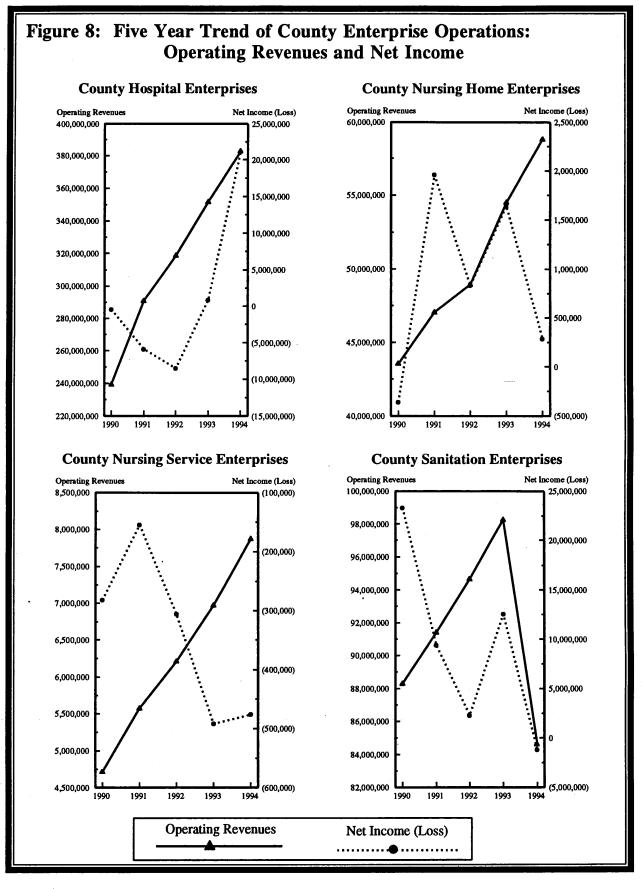
In addition to providing services that are accounted for in governmental funds, counties also provided services through county-established enterprises that are intended to be self-sustaining through fees and user charges. Hospitals, nursing homes, and solid-waste management facilities are commonly operated as enterprises.

In 1994, county enterprise operations had operating expenses of \$625.8 million and operating revenues of \$625.7 million, resulting in an operating loss of \$52,994. County enterprises had nonoperating expenses of \$17.2 million, nonoperating revenues of \$43.0 million, and a net income of \$25.7 million. Net income increased 14.2 percent between 1993 and 1994.

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DEFINITION OF TERMS

BORROWING - Includes the sale of bonds and notes, certificates of indebtedness, and tax anticipation certificates. Counties are restricted by law from borrowing for current expense.

CAPITAL OUTLAY - The purchase or construction of buildings, permanent improvements, equipment, machinery and land. Capital outlay varies from year to year based on the needs and resources of the counties.

CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND - A fund created to account for the financial resources that are used for the acquisition or construction of a fixed asset. An example of this fund type is a highway improvement fund.

CHARGES FOR SERVICES - Fees for activities of the governmental funds. These include rent of government buildings by individuals or organizations, road and bridge services, recreation fees, park fees, etc.

CONSERVATION OF NATURAL RESOURCES - Activities designed to conserve and develop such natural resources as water, soil, forests and minerals

CURRENT EXPENDITURES - Expenditures which benefit the current fiscal period. Expenditures included in this definition are salaries, pension contributions, operating expenses, etc.

DEBT SERVICE FUNDS - A fund to account for the collection of resources and payment of long-term debt principal and interest. An example of this fund type is the 1991 improvement bond.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT - Expenditures associated with planning and providing adequate housing and redevelopment of substandard physical facilities. Expenditures directed toward developing an area or providing assistance and opportunity to persons and business for such development.

ENTERPRISE FUNDS - A fund established to account for operations financed and operated in a manner similar to private business, e.g., hospitals and nursing homes. The expenses of providing services are primarily financed by user charges.

FINES AND FORFEITS - Receipts from the payment of penalties for law violations, non-observance of contracts and forfeited deposits.

GENERAL FUND - The fund used to account for all financial resources not required to be accounted for in another fund. This fund is the main operating fund.

GENERAL GOVERNMENT - Expenditures related to the administration of the governmental unit.

DEFINITION OF TERMS

GOVERNMENTAL FUNDS - The funds through which most governmental activities are financed. The four governmental fund types are: general, special revenue, debt service and capital projects.

HEALTH - Expenditures include mental health centers, general clinics, preparation of vital statistics (birth and death records), disease control, etc.

HIGHWAYS - Expenditures include maintenance of highways, patching, seal coating, and snow removal. Highway construction, bridge repair and construction, and purchase and maintenance of street equipment are also included. Includes expenditures on all county highways, including county state-aid highways.

HUMAN SERVICES - Expenditures include Medical Assistance, Aid to Families with Dependent Children, General Assistance, Food Stamps, other income maintenance services, social services, etc.

INTEREST EARNINGS - Includes interest earned on checking and savings accounts, CD's, money market funds, and Treasury Bonds and bills.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL REVENUES - Revenues from other governments in the form of grants, entitlements, shared revenues or payments in lieu of taxes.

LIBRARIES - Expenditures include the purchase of reference materials and books, reference services to patrons, cataloging of materials and general administration of the library.

LICENSES AND PERMITS - Business licenses and permits are receipts from business and occupations that must be licensed before doing business in the county. Non-business licenses and permits are revenues levied according to benefits presumably conferred by the license or permit.

MISCELLANEOUS EXPENDITURES - Expenditures include all expenses that were not allocated to a specific function.

MISCELLANEOUS REVENUES - Includes refunds, reimbursements, donations, and lease payments.

NET TAX LEVY - The county property taxes, net of state property tax relief aids or grants, required to be paid by the property owners of the county.

OTHER FINANCING SOURCES - Long-term debt proceeds, sale of fixed assets and transfers in from other funds.

OTHER FINANCING USES - Transfers out to other funds, refunding bond proceeds deposited with escrow agent, and remittance to other agencies.

DEFINITION OF TERMS

PARKS AND RECREATION - Expenditures for park maintenance, mowing, planting and removal of trees. Recreation expenditures include festivals, bands, museums, community centers, cable TV, baseball fields, organized recreation activities, etc.

PUBLIC SAFETY - Expenditures for the sheriff, corrections, traffic safety, building inspections, civil defense, etc.

SANITATION - Expenditures include refuse collection and disposal, recycling, street cleaning, and weed and pest control.

SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS - A levy made against certain properties to defray all or part of the costs of a specific improvement, such as new sewer and water mains, deemed to benefit primarily those properties. The amount includes the penalties and interest paid on the assessments.

SPECIAL REVENUE FUNDS - A fund used to account for the proceeds of specific revenue sources that are restricted to expenditures for a specific purpose.

TAXABLE TAX CAPACITY - The tax capacity less the tax increment district value, less the fiscal disparities contribution value plus the fiscal disparities distribution value.

TAX CAPACITY - The value assigned to the property used to calculate the property taxes.

TAXES - Revenues include property taxes, penalties and interest on delinquent property taxes, fiscal disparities, forfeited tax sales, gravel taxes, and tax increment taxes if not shown separately.

TAX INCREMENTS - Taxes collected on tax-increment financing projects. Taxincrement financing is a tool which counties use to redevelop a portion of the county. The increase in taxes on the redeveloped area is used to cover the county costs associated with the project.

TOTAL EXPENDITURES - Includes current operating expenses, capital outlays and debt service principal and interest payments.

TOTAL REVENUES - Receipt of monies that increases the amount of available resources without creating a liability or a future payment. Borrowing and transfersbetween funds are not included in total revenues.

TRANSFERS - ENTERPRISE FUNDS - The transfer of available resources to or from public service enterprises. It is shown separately because enterprise funds are not included in the governmental funds.

TRANSFERS - GOVERNMENTAL FUNDS - The transfer of money between governmental fund types. The revenues and expenditures for these funds are always shown in the same tables.

- Revenues, Expenditures and Debt of the Towns in Minnesota December 31, 1993 This annual report lists the sources and amounts of revenues, expenditures and outstanding debt for Minnesota towns for the most recent fiscal year. August 1995
- Revenues, Expenditures and Debt of Minnesota Counties December 31, 1994 This annual report lists the sources and audited amounts of revenues, expenditures and debt for Minnesota counties during the most recent fiscal year. It includes analyses of counties' enterprise operations, such as hospitals. May 1996
- A Guide to City and County Fund Balances December 31, 1994 This annual report provides an overview of Minnesota cities' and counties' fund balances. It defines "fund balance" and identifies fund-balance trends. May 1996
