## Dear Senators, Representatives, Ms. Studders, Mr. Dunn:

We are pleased to transmit to you this supplemental report on the Solid Waste Management Tax (SWMT) receipts for January 1999. In conjunction with the three 1998 SWMT revenue reports distributed to you, it will more accurately represent the revenues of the first calendar year. The January 1998 revenues were expected to be low, since the tax remitted January 1998 was from tax collections made in 1997 for future services to be had in 1998 (SWMT first became effective for services rendered in January 1998). This report completes the year by showing the amount collected December 1998, or before, and remitted with the January 1999 return.

As a convenience to you, this supplemental report charts the monthly totals for 1998. It also gives distribution totals for the Solid Waste Generator Assessment (SWGA) and SCORE tax (sales tax on waste services) for tax periods pre-1998. The total for SWMT received and distributed from January through December 1998 is \$40.33 million. The total SWMT received and distributed January 1999 is \$4.14 million, for a grand total of \$44.47 million.
