UNDER THE FEDERAL CONTRACT FOR FISCAL YEAR
ENDING JUNE 30, 1974

INTRODUCTION

Eighteen counties (the same number as last year) participated in the Indian Foster Care Program during 1973-74 fiscal year. Two of these, Red Lake and Cook, were new counties. Two counties participating the prior year, Ramsey and Goodhue, reported no costs for 1973-74.

Note: In addition to the \$153,203.08 contributed for foster care expenses in 1973-74 \$15,320.31 of Federal Funds was contributed for administrative expense in the counties. Plus \$5,000.00 to Beltrami County for additional costs for maintaining a Red Lake Branch Office, and \$8,000.00 for State Office administrative expenses for a federal money total of \$181,523.39.

Cost of Care and Number of Children - Three Counties Share more than half State Total

During the 1973-74 Fiscal Year Beltrami, Cass and Mille Lacs counties served 54.2% of the Indian children receiving reimbursed care under the Indian contract, and had 54.8% of the reported expenditures.

Costs as well as Children Served Decreased

All expenditures except miscellaneous type expenses decreased from the prior year. Number of children receiving reimbursed care decreased for all types of expense other than medical. For detail see the table below:

Living Arrangement - 91.6% Live in Foster Family Homes

The program total of 107 Indian children have living arrangements classified as either foster homes or institutions. The majority or 98 live in foster homes, including seven children who also lived in institutions part of the year. Fifteen percent lived in institutions during the year. Both children in foster homes and children in institutions decreased from 1973, (-30.0% and -15.8%, respectively).

Supervising agency is divided between public and private (voluntary). The public agencies supervised 90.7% of the children. This includes seven children who were supervised part of the year by private agencies, and the rest by public.

The large decrease in children supervised by private agencies (-51.4%) is at least partially due to a change in procedure resulting in claims being paid directly to counties only, rather than directly to both public and private agencies.

Board and Room Costs - Average Daily Costs ^{up} ^{17%} more than ~~1.770~~

The total board and room average daily cost was \$6.11 per child in Fiscal Year 1974. This is up \$.90 or 17.3% from Fiscal Year 1973. The average daily cost for board and room per child for state wards and non-state wards is \$4.41 and \$6.84, respectively, which is a decrease in average day costs for state wards - 2.9% which is more than offset by the 23.7% increase in average daily costs for non-state wards.

Days of Care - Average 254 Days Per Year Per Child - State Wards Average Days Exceeds Non-State Wards Average

Days of care for board and room totaled 26,405 which represents 254 average number of days care per child. The number of children receiving board and room payments were 104 or 97.2% of the total number of children (107). The average number of days care per child was 266 days for state wards compared to 249 days for non-state wards. In fiscal 1974 the number of children receiving board and room decreased -31.6% from fiscal 1973, while the number of days care per child increased 19.8% over fiscal 1973.

Closings exceed Openings by 52 Children - The table below shows the number of case openings and closings for Indian children under the Indian Foster Care Contract since Fiscal Year 1964:

Clothing Expenditures - Average \$88.09

In 1973-74 less than half the children received money for clothing (47.7% compared to 61.6% in 1972-73). A few years before in 1970-71, better than 3/4 of children received clothing payments. Yearly cost per child for clothing in Fiscal Year 1973 was \$88.09 an increase of \$1.27 or 1.5%.

Medical Costs Allowed

In 1973-74 medical costs were allowed for six cases in which all other possible sources for medical costs had been denied. Medical care costs allowed, totaled \$265.36 or \$44.23 per child.

Miscellaneous Costs - Average \$132.05

The average yearly cost per child for miscellaneous expense was \$132.05 an increase of \$42.08 (46.8%) from Fiscal Year 1973. This is due to the uneven rate of decrease in number of children receiving miscellaneous costs. A slightly greater proportion of children received miscellaneous costs reimbursement in 1973-74 than in the prior year (53.3% compared to 49.1%).
