NOTES AND DISCUSSIONS

The source of the data in these tables is Summary Tape File 1 (STF 1) of the 1980 Census. The following notes should be taken into account when using the data in the tables.

DEFINITIONS

Family:

Two or more persons, including the householder, who are related by birth, marriage or adoption and who live together as one household. All such persons are considered as members of one family. Persons not in families and not inmates of institutions are classified as Unrelated Individuals.

Household Relationship:

The relationship to the person in column one of the Census questionnaire. Persons in the household include the following.

Householder The person who was reported in column one, intended to be the person in whose name the home was owned or rented.

Family Householder A householder living with one or more persons related to him or her by birth, marriage or adoption.

Nonfamily Householder A householder living alone or only with persons unrelated to him or her.

Child A son, daughter, stepchild or adopted child of the householder, regardless of the child's age or marital status. The category excludes sons-in-law, daughters-in-law, and foster children.

"SAMPLE AND "100% COMPLETE COUNT" DATA

There were two types of 1980 Census questionnaires, the "short form" and the "long form".

On the short form, seven questions were asked about each household member, nine about the housing unit, and three to ensure that no person associated with the household was overlooked. Data from the "short form" is called "complete count" or "100 percent" data.

The same questions appeared on the long form with additional questions on 26 population and 20 housing subjects. Long form questionnaires were given to about 16 percent of all housing units, except for governmental jurisdictions of less than 2,500 inhabitants where the sampling rate is changed to 50 percent of all housing units. Data from the "long form" is called sample data.

All income related data is derived from long form, the "sample" questionnaires.

POVERTY STATUS

Families and individuals are classified as above or below the poverty level by comparing their total 1979 income to an income cutoff or "poverty threshold". The income cutoffs vary by family size, number of children, and age of the family householder or unrelated individual. Poverty status is determined for all families. Poverty status is also determined for persons not in families, except for inmates of institutions, members of the Armed Forces living in barracks, college students living in dormitories, and unrelated individuals under 15 years old. Poverty status is derived on a sample basis.

SUPPRESSION

To maintain the confidentiality promised respondents and required by law, the Census Bureau takes precautions to make sure that its public data do not disclose information about particular individuals or housing units; therefore the Bureau suppresses tabulations of characteristics for very small groups of people or housing units. There are two types of suppression, primary and complementary.

Primary Suppression

Suppression of Population Characteristics Characteristics of persons other than race or Spanish origin (e.g., age, relationship) are shown only if there are 30 or more persons in the geographic area. For example, on a record for a census tract with a population of 1 to 29 persons, population characteristics such as age and relationship are suppressed. Only counts for total population and the number of persons within specific race or Spanish origin groups are provided.

Suppression of Family or Household Characteristics Characteristics of families and households are shown if there are at least ten occupied housing units within the geographic area tabulated.

Suppression of Tables Cross-Classified by Race or Spanish Origin Population and housing characteristics cross-classified by race or Spanish origin are subject to an additional level of scrutiny. This level requires the 30 person or ten household criteria to apply to each race or Spanish origin group.

Complementary Suppression

In some cases complementary suppression is applied to prevent the derivation of suppressed data by subtraction. For instance, when a table shows the "number of persons in unit" for all households and also for renters, there must be at least ten owners and ten renters for the renter data to be shown; otherwise, the characteristics of the owners could be derived by subtracting renter data from data for all households.

The data in this report that are affected by suppression are those cross-classifying race by poverty status. The following table lists the counties and categories involving suppression.
