#### NOTES ON DATA USED IN TABLES

The source of the data in these tables is Summary Tape File 1 (STF 1) of the 1980 Census. The following notes should be taken into account when using data in the tables.

### Under 18 Population

The data for persons under 18 as householder or spouse, in married couple family, or in single parent family do not include persons under 18 who are living with other relatives (2.5% of under 18 population) living with non-relatives (1.1%) living in group quarters (0.4%).

With regard to the data for households with persons under 18, similarly, 0.7% of the households with persons under 18 are omitted, as they do not fall into one of the three family types selected.

### Persons by Race

Only the "races" of highest incidence have been tabulated. In fact these are a combination of racial and ethnic data in that Spanish origin is an ethnic, not a racial category.

### Over Age 65 Population

Only the minority groups of highest incidence have been tabulated.

### Community Action Agency Tabulations

Totals for East and West Polk and East and West Marshall Counties have been calculated by aggregating township data.

Some differences from county totals involving these counties may occur because of suppression of data which the Census Bureau uses to insure confidentiality of the data. Suppression occurs either when there are fewer than 15 persons or 5 housing units in the area being summarized (this is called primary suppression), or because an item subject to primary suppression can be obtained by subtraction. This second type is called complementary suppression.

Suppression in these data is most likely to have occurred in township tabulations of minorities.
