


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INTRODUCTION

This publication contains household projections for the state of Minnesota and for counties and development regions for the years 1985, 1990 and 2000. There are two sets of projections, a high series and a low series. For counties, the projections are for the total number of households only. For the state and the regions, the projections are broken down by household type and age and sex of the householder. Following 1980 Census terminology, the term "householder" is used to designate the person (or one of the persons) in whose name the housing unit is owned or rented. This term replaces the head of household designation used in previous censuses.

METHODOLOGY

Regional and State Projections: The first step in the projections was to calculate householder rates for each region and the state in 1980. The householder rate is the proportion of the population listed as householders. There is one and only one householder in each household, so the total number of households is equivalent to the total number of householders. Householder rates were calculated for each age/sex group and for each of the three household types--married couple families, other families, and non-family households. (Non-family households are either one person living alone or two or more unrelated persons sharing living quarters.) Hennepin and Ramsey Counties, which have a distinctive household profile, were combined and examined separately from the other counties in Region 11.

For married couple householders and other family householders, householder rates had to be approximated. The number of married couple householders in 1980 was available only for broad age groups. Estimates for finer age breakdowns were obtained by multiplying the number of married individuals, available for more detailed age groups, by the ratio of married couple householders to married individuals in the broader age groups. For family households other than married couples, householder rates were available only by broad age groups. The rates for more detailed age categories were assumed to be constant within these broad age groups.

After householder rates had been calculated, the next step was to figure the percent change in these rates between 1970 and 1980. These rates of change were calculated only for the state as a whole and were assumed to be the same in all regions. For married couple householders, the percent change in the proportion married was used as a proxy for the change in the householder rate, which was not directly available.

The rates of change in householder proportions during the 1970s were substantial, especially among younger age groups. Younger people were much more likely to be non-family or single person family householders in 1980 than in 1970. The proportion who were married couple householders decreased. Among older people this trend was less obvious; there was even a slight increase in the proportion of married couple householders.

High and Low Projection Series: The high and low projection alternatives make different assumptions about the degree to which the household composition changes of the 1970s will continue into the future.

The low scenario assumes that change will continue at 25% of the 1970-1980 rate. For example, if the proportion of males 45-54 who were non-family householders increased 41.7% in 1970-1980, it was assumed to increase at 25% of this rate, or 10.4%, in 1980-1990. In the high scenario, change was assumed to continue at 50% of the 1970-1980 rate. In the example just given, it was assumed that the proportion of 45-54 year old males who are non-family householders would increase 20.9%. After 1990, rates were assumed to remain constant.

In general, the rapid rates of social change observed in the 1970s were assumed to slow down. The 1970s witnessed great changes in household structure and living arrangements. It would be difficult to maintain such high rates of change for an indefinite period. If these high rates of change are assumed to continue, the results become statistically absurd. In some age categories there would be more householders than persons, a clear impossibility.

An example of regional householder rates and how they vary according to the projection assumptions can be provided by a look at the figures for males 35-44 in Region 1. In 1980, .83 were married couple householders, .03 were householders in other families, and .06 were non-family householders. The remainder (.08) lived in group quarters or in households where someone else, e.g., a spouse or roommate, was listed as the householder. Under the "low" scenario, the projected 1990 proportions would be .82 married couple householders, .03 other family householders, and .07 non-family householders. Projected 1990 proportions under the "high" scenario are .81 married couple householders, .03 for other family householders, and .08 for non-family householders. These figures

demonstrate that when the changes of the 1970s are assumed to continue, the proportion of married males goes down and the proportion in a non-family household goes up.

The new proportions calculated according to the high and low alternatives were next multiplied by the projected population in each age/sex group to produce the projected number of households. This was done for the state and for each development region. The projected population numbers came from Minnesota Population Projections: 1980-2010 (Minnesota State Demography Unit, 1983). Calculations were done for the years 1985, 1990, and 2000. The total number of householders in any given age/sex group was not allowed to exceed 95% of the projected population in that age group. For each age/sex group and household type, the regional totals were controlled to the state total. The projections for the state and the regions may be found in Tables 1 through 15. All numbers were rounded to the nearest 10. Because of rounding, the totals do not always match exactly.

Persons Per Household (PPH): The projected number of persons per households (PPH) was obtained for each region and projection scenario by dividing the projected household population by the projected number of households. In the calculations of household population, it was assumed that the proportion of the population living in households would be the same in future years as in 1980. As can be seen from Table 16, even the "low" assumption shows a decline in the number of persons per household over time. The lowest PPH figures under all alternatives are found in Hennepin and Ramsey Counties.

County Projections: Projections for counties are for the total number of households only. They are not broken down by age of householder or household type. The county projections were derived by dividing the projected county household population by the projected PPH. The regional PPH figure was used for all counties within the region. As with the regions, the proportion of the population living in households was assumed to remain at a constant 1980 level. The county household projections, found in Table 17, were controlled to the regional totals. All numbers were rounded to the nearest 100.

The major factor determining county household projections is the projected population. Counties with large projected population increases generally have large increases in projected number of households. A secondary factor is change in PPH. The sharper the decline in projected PPH, the greater the proportional projected increase in households.

Differences from Earlier Projections: The numbers of households projected in this publication are generally higher than earlier household projections published by the Office of the State Demographer in Minnesota Population Projections: 1970-2000 (1975). For example, for the year 2000 the earlier projection for the state was 1,726,700 households. The new projection series for the same year gives two alternatives, with 1,869,700 as the low figure and 1,941,600 as the high figure. The differences occur partly because of differences in the projected number of people and partly because of differences in the assumptions about household change and composition. The earlier projections assumed a higher initial PPH figure, and also assumed that householder rates would not change over time.
