
This publication provides average covered employment and total wages on a two digit of industry break for each economic region for the calendar year 1986. The unit totals represent an unduplicated count of units active in the industry during the entire year rather than at any fixed point. Industries are classified according to the 1972 Standard Industrial Classification Manual.

The following are not covered by the Minnesota Employment Services Law and do not appear in the data:

- the self-employed;
- 2) farms with less than four employees in 20 weeks;
- 3) all railroad transportation employment;
- 4) insurance and real estate salespeople who work only on a commission basis;
- 5) students working for the school while a full-time student;
- 6) those employed by a church for religious work;
- 7) minor children, spouse and parents working for the owner of a business;
- 8) elected officials at the Federal, State and Local level of government;
- 9) the Red Lake Chippewa Tribe.

Asterisks (*) indicate that there are too few employing establishments in an industry to allow publication in accordance with the State's nondisclosure law. Where two or more industries within a major industry grouping cannot be disclosed, both have been marked with asterisks, but employment and wages for both are still included in the major industry total. Where only one industry could not be disclosed, we have rolled that industry's data into another, marking the nondisclosure with an asterisk and the combined industries with a commercial A (@).

The pages labelled "unallocated" that appears after Region 11 include such persons as traveling salespeople who have no fixed location and those few employers who are not able to break out multiple locations.
