
INTRODUCTION

The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources polled 2400 Minnesota citizens, four hundred from each of the six DNR regions. The purpose of the poll was to gauge the level of public support for present and potential Department programs, and to find out what the public feels are the top natural resource issues facing the state. The poll arose out of the Department's strategic planning and marketing efforts and results of the poll will benefit both efforts.

Contained herein are the statewide and regional results of the poll. The format of the presentation of results is the same as the format of the telephone interview. The first part of the presentation is on questions administered throughout the state; the latter parts are on questions that are specific to each of the DNR regions.

The poll was conducted by the Minnesota Center for Survey Research, University of Minnesota - Twin Cities, during the months of November and December 1988. It was conducted concurrently with an outdoor recreation facility adequacy survey for the State Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan. Results of the facility adequacy survey will be reported in the 1989 SCORP.
