


This report covers grants made by the Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Board (IRRRB) to local governments and organizations located within the Taconite Tax Relief Area. It is important to note that the money for these grants does not come from the state general fund. Rather, these funds are of local origin, derived from taconite production taxes based on tons of taconite mined and taxes levied in lieu of property taxes on the area mining companies.

Because of this taxing mechanism, the Iron Range area has been able to combat the boom and bust cycles commonly associated with mineral extraction. IRRRB grants for economic and community development have helped to provide a strong base for ongoing diversification efforts. My visits to other parts of our country which are overly dependent on mining have reinforced my belief that diversification is the key to a brighter future for northeastern Minnesota. The projects listed in this report serve as evidence of our commitment to the future viability of this region.


Dear Reader:

## Grant Report, 1977 - 1990

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The Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Board, IRRRB, was created by the 52nd Legislature in 1941, during a period of economic upheaval for northeastern Minnesota. (See Appendix A.1). Extensive lumbering had left much of the area "cut over," and technological advances in the mining industry had dramatically lowered the demand for large numbers of laborers.

Funded by five percent of the iron ore occupation tax, the Commissioner of the Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation was instructed to:

- \* Develop low grade iron ore
- \* Develop peat and other remaining natural resources
- \* Promote vocational training
- \* Expand tourist facilities and attractions
- \* Promote long range forestry programs in 16 "cutover" counties
- \* Develop agriculture
- \* Promote processing of wood products
- \* Establish paper mills
- \* Develop a program of rehabilitating the unemployed and under-employed

In 1943, the 53rd Legislature created an advisory commission to assist the Commissioner in his efforts to improve the economic base of the Iron Range. The commission consisted of three members of the Senate, appointed by the Senate Committee on Committees; three members of the House, appointed by the Speaker of the House, and the Commissioner of Conservation.


In the 1970's, the Board was expanded to its present size with the addition of two senators and two representatives. The broad powers given to the Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Board back in 1941 have resulted in a great amount of exploration, experimentation and implementation. Out of this has emerged a state agency that is highly diversified in its efforts to improve the economic stability of northeastern Minnesota.

Grants and loans made by the Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Board in the 40's, 50's and 60's reflected a philosophy of natural resource development. The agency made or contributed to water quality and quantity surveys, land ownership maps, forest resources and a number of other projects which sought to "develop the remaining resources," as mentioned in the original legislation. Business assistance consisted of loans to area entrepreneurs for the purchase of land, buildings and equipment. Grants for infrastructure, tourism development, and municipal facilities, which indirectly support economic development, were made on a relatively small scale.

The 5% share of the iron ore occupation tax, which was imposed on the production and shipping of high-grade ores, was the only source of revenue for the IRRRB. With the depletion of high grade ores and technological advancements in taconite processing, the production of taconite rose to meet the demands of the steel industry. Thus, as natural ore shipments decreased in the 1960's, less and less money became available for IRRRB use. Because of this, experts predicted that by 1975 the Mesabi Iron Range would be exhausted of its natural ore supply.

Due to the reduction in revenues, the IRRRB faced the possibility of discontinuance. In 1971, the Legislature appropriated one cent per ton of the production tax on taconite in order to continue the operation of the agency.

In 1977, legislation increased this amount and provided a formula for the distribution of the taconite production tax. Of particular importance was the increase in revenues to the IRRRB and the creation of the Taconite Area Environmental Protection Fund (See Appendix A.2). As a result, the IRRRB Grant Program, as we now know it, was created. Graph 1 below shows receipts by the IRRRB from the iron ore occupation tax and the taconite production tax from 1942-1989.



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The taconite mining companies make the production tax payments directly to the six counties affected (Aitkin, Cook, Crow Wing, Itasca, Lake, and St. Louis) and the IRRRB. The county auditor of each county is responsible for taconite aid payments to the taxing jurisdictions within the county. St. Louis County was designated as fiscal agent for the taconite property tax relief account and issues taconite property tax relief checks to the other five counties. The Department of Revenue makes all computations regarding the amount to be paid by the companies and the aid payments due to cities, schools, townships and counties. Interest earnings on undistributed funds are remitted by the counties to the IRRRB. Table 1 shows the current distribution of the taconite production tax (1988 taxes payable in 1989) as dictated by statute.

\*For the 1988 production year, the cents-per-ton distribution was frozen at 20.5 cents for the county fund and 5.5 cents for the county road and bridge fund.

\*\*These funds are escalated using the Gross National Product Implicit Price Deflator. After escalation, the cents-per-ton for Taconite Property Tax Relief was 20.0-cents, IRRRB was 5.0-cents and the N.E. Minnesota Economic Protection Fund was 2.5-cents.

Note: The majority of the remaining proceeds from the production tax distribution is divided between the Taconite Area Environmental Protection Fund, two-thirds of the residual, and the Northeast Minnesota Economic Protection Fund, one-third of the residual.

Since these revenues are in lieu of property taxes levied on the mining companies, eligibility for grant qualification is limited to those communities and/or organized townships that lie within the boundaries of the Taconite Tax Relief Area as defined in Minnesota Statutes 273.134, Taconite and Iron Ore Areas; Tax Relief Area; Definitions:

*For the purposes of this section and Section 273,135, "municipality" means any city, however organized, or town, and the applicable assessment date is the date as which property is listed and assessed for the tax in question.*

*For the purposes of Section 273.135 "tax relief area" means the geographic area contained, within the boundaries of a school district which contains a municipality which meets the following qualifications:*

- (1) it is a municipality in which the assessed valuation of unmined iron ore on May 1, 1941, was not less than 40 percent of the assessed valuation of all real property and in which, as of the applicable date, the assessed valuation of unmined iron ore is not more than 60 percent of the assessed valuation of all real property; or*
- (2) it is a municipality in which, on January 1, 1977 or the applicable assessment date, there is a taconite concentrating plant or where taconite is mined or quarried or where there is located an electric generating plant which qualifies as a taconite facility.*



The Taconite Area Environmental Protection Fund is the source of the majority of current IRRRB grants, however, smaller grants are made out of the Board and Northeast Accounts contingent upon availability of funds and criteria governing use of funds. IRRRB funded projects are intended to directly or indirectly impact the economic development of the various units of government throughout the Taconite Tax Relief Area. To further evaluate specific areas of funding for this report, the following categories have been developed:

- \* Airports
- \* Business Development
- \* Community Development
- \* Mineland Reclamation
- \* Recreation
- \* Tourism
- \* Water & Sewer

The pie chart below shows the percentage of total spent in each grant category from 1977-1991\*.







**Business Development** - These projects include revolving loan funds, building renovations, industrial parks, feasibility studies, job fairs, etc.







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

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**Mineland Reclamation** - These projects include revitalization and revegetation of abandoned mine pits, boat landings, camp sites, picnic areas and fish stocking.




The St. James Pit located in Aurora, Minnesota




Pennington Mine boat access located in Ironton, Minnesota

Year-round Ski Jump located in Ely



## APPENDIX A.1

### §298.22 IRON RANGE RESOURCES AND REHABILITATION.

*Subdivision 1. (1) The office of commissioner of iron range resources is created. The commissioner shall be appointed by the governor under provisions of section 15.06. (2) The commissioner may hold such other positions or appointment as are not incompatible with duties as commissioner of iron range resources and rehabilitation. The commissioner may appoint a deputy commissioner. All expenses of the commissioner, including the payment of such assistance as may be necessary, shall be paid out of the amounts appropriated by section 298.28. The compensation of the commissioner shall be set by the legislative coordinating commission and may not exceed the maximum salary set for the commissioner of administration under section 15A.081, subdivision 1. (3) When the commissioner shall determine that distress and unemployment exists or may exist in the future in any county by reason of the removal of natural resources or a possibly limited use thereof in the future and the decrease in employment appropriation made to the commissioner of revenue in section 298.28 as are determined to be necessary and proper in the development of the remaining resources of said county and in the vocational training and rehabilitation of its residents, except that the amount needed to cover cost overruns awarded to a contractor by an arbitrator in relation to a contract awarded by the commissioner or in effect after July 1, 1985, is appropriated from the general fund. For the purposes of this section, "development of remaining resources" includes, but is not limited to, the promotion of tourism.*

*Subdivision 2. There is hereby created the iron range resources and rehabilitation board, consisting of 11 members, five of whom shall be state senators, appointed by the subcommittee on committees of the rules committee of the senate, and five of who shall be representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives, their terms of office to commence on May 1, 1943, and continue until January 3rd, 1945, or until their successors are appointed and qualified. Their successors shall be appointed each two years in the same manner as the original members were appointed, in January of every second year, commencing on January, 1945. The 11th member of said board shall be the commissioner of natural resources of the state of Minnesota. Vacancies of the board shall be filled in the same manner as the original members were chosen. At least a majority of the legislative members of the board shall be elected from state senatorial or legislative districts in which over 50 percent of the resident reside within a tax relief area as defined in section 273.134. All expenditures and projects made by the commissioner of iron range resources and rehabilitation shall first be submitted to said iron range resources and rehabilitation board which shall recommend approval or disapproval or modification of expenditures and projects for rehabilitation purposes as provided by this section, and the method, manner, and time of payment of all said funds proposed to be disbursed shall be first approved or disapproved by the said board. The board shall biennially make its report to the governor and the legislature on or before November 15 of each even numbered year. The expenses of said board shall be paid by the state of Minnesota from the funds raised pursuant to this section.*

*Subdivision 3. Whenever the commissioner of iron range resources and rehabilitation has made determinations required by subdivision 1 and has determined that distress and unemployment exists or may exist in the future in any county by reason of the removal of the natural resources or a possible limited use thereof in the future and the decrease in employment resulting therefrom and deems that the acquirement of real estate or personal property is necessary and proper in the development of the remaining resources, the commissioner may acquire such property or interests therein by gift, purchase or lease. The commissioner may purchase insurance to protect any property acquired from loss or damage by fire, or to protect the commissioner from any liability the commissioner may incur by reason of ownership of the property or both. If after such property is acquired it is necessary in the judgement of the commissioner to acquired right-of-way for access to projects operated on property acquired, by gift, purchase or lease, said right-of-*

way may be acquired by condemnation in the manner provided by law.

*Subdivision 4. Whenever property has been granted and conveyed to the state of Minnesota in accordance with an agreement made by the commissioner of iron range resources and rehabilitation and the commissioner of administration for the necessary and proper development of the remaining resources of any distressed county, such grants, and conveyances or leases are hereby accepted in accordance with the terms and conditions thereof.*

*Subdivision 5. In order to carry out the terms and provisions of this section, the commissioner of iron range resources and rehabilitation and the commissioner of administration may lease any property acquired hereunder for a term not to exceed 20 years upon such terms as they may determine, provided that such property shall not be leased to any person in such a manner as to constitute a direct contribution of working capital to a business enterprise. Such lease may provide that in the event the property is ever sold by the state to such lessee, the lessee may obtain credit on the purchase price covering the rentals paid under the lease or any renewals thereof and that said real estate can be conveyed by the commissioner of iron range resources and rehabilitation and the commissioner of administration and the said commissioners are hereby authorized to make such conveyances.*

**§298.223 TACONITE AREA ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION FUND**

**Subdivision 1. Creation; Purposes.** *A fund called the Taconite Environmental Protection Fund is created for the purpose of reclaiming, restoring and enhancing those areas of northeastern Minnesota located within a tax relief area defined in Section §273.134 that are adversely affected by the environmental damaging operations involved in mining taconite and iron ore and producing iron ore concentrate and for the purpose of promoting the economic development of northeastern Minnesota. The Taconite Environmental Protection Fund shall be used for the following purposes:*

- (a) *to initiate investigations into matters the Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Board determines are in need of study and which will determine the environmental problems requiring remedial action;*
- (b) *reclamation, restoration, or reforestation of minelands not otherwise provided for by state law;*
- (c) *local economic development projects including construction of sewer and water systems, and other public works located within a tax relief area defined in Section §273.134;*
- (d) *monitoring of mineral industry-related health problems among mining employees.*

**Subdivision 2. Administration.** *The Taconite Environmental Protection Fund shall be administered by the Commissioner of the Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Board. The Commissioner, shall by September 1 of each year, prepare a list of projects to be funded from the Taconite Area Environmental Protection Fund, with such supporting information including description of the projects, plans and cost estimates as may be necessary. Upon recommendation of the Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Board, this list shall be submitted to the Legislative Advisory Commission for its review. This list, with the recommendation of the Legislative Advisory Commission, shall then be transmitted to the Governor by November 1 of each year. By December 1 of each year, the Governor shall approve or disapprove, or return for further consideration, each project. Funds for a project may be expended only upon approval of the project by the Governor.*

*The Commissioner may submit supplemental projects for approval at any time. Supplemental projects approved by the Board must be submitted to the members of the Legislative Advisory Commission for their review and recommendations of further review. If a recommendation is not provided within ten days, no further review by the Legislative Advisory Commission is required, and the Governor shall approve or disapprove each project or return it for further consideration. If the recommendation by any member is for further review, the Governor shall submit the request to the Legislative Advisory Commission for its review and recommendation. Failure or refusal of the commission to make a recommendation promptly is a negative recommendation.*

**Subdivision 3. Appropriation.** *There is hereby annually appropriated to the Commissioner of Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation such funds as are necessary to carry out the projects approved and such funds as are necessary for administration of this section. Annual administrative costs, not including detailed engineering expenses for the projects, shall not exceed five percent of the amount annually expended from the fund.*

*Funds for the purpose of this section are provided by Section §298.28, Subdivision II, relating to the Taconite Environmental Protection Fund.*
